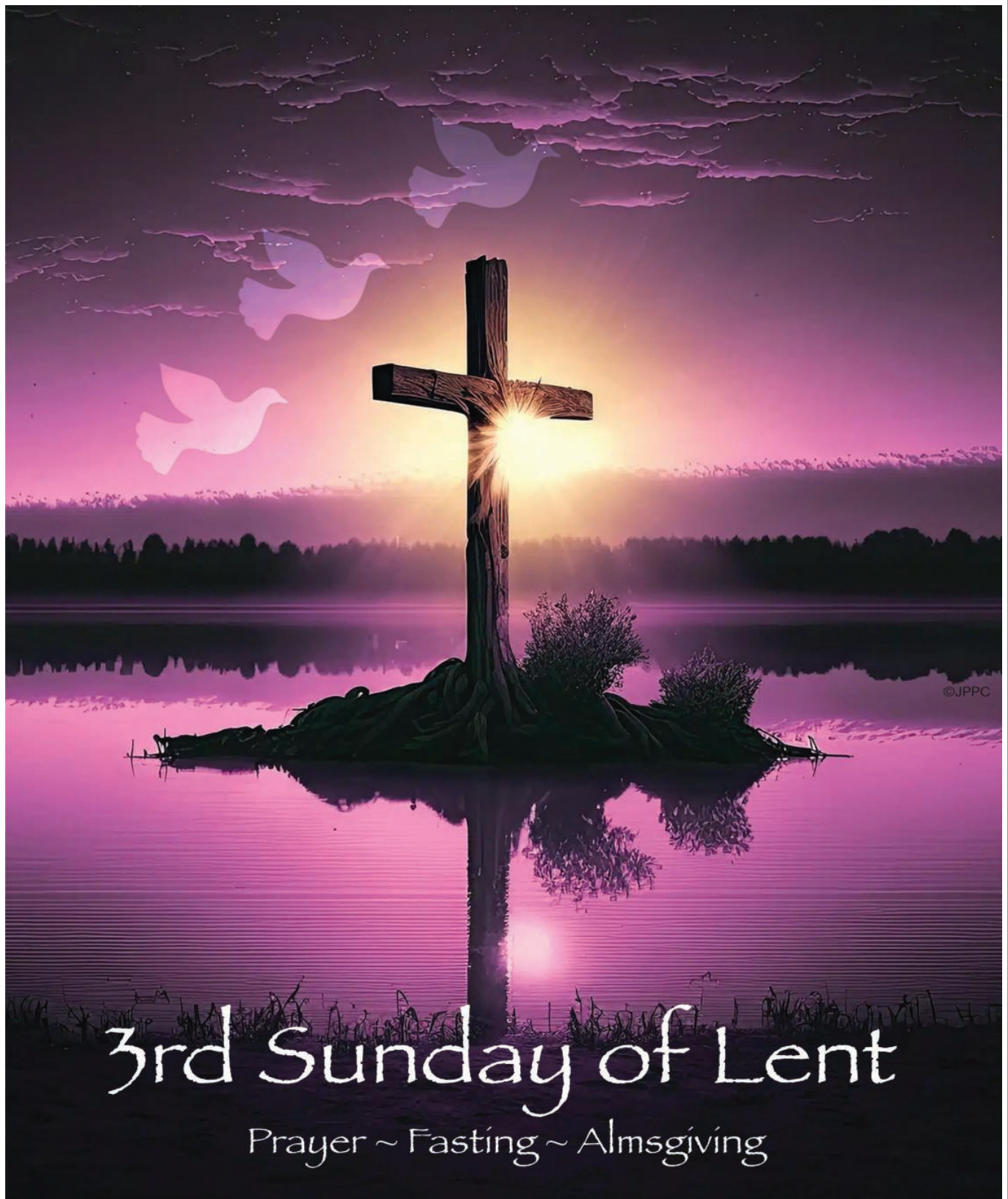

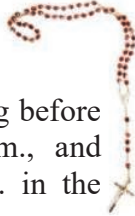
## Pilgrim Statue Our Lady of Fatima

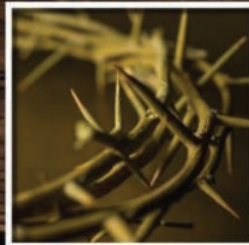
