## From Father:

*In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus offers us a beautiful and simple promise: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." These few words are rich in meaning, especially as we celebrate both **Good Shepherd Sunday** and **Mother's Day** today.*

*Jesus, the Good Shepherd, speaks to us—not from afar, but as one who knows us intimately. His voice isn't harsh or condemning, but gentle and guiding. He knows our name. He knows our story. He offers us security in an uncertain world: "No one can take them out of my hand." In His care, we are safe.*

*Isn't that also what we experience through the love of a mother?*

*A mother's voice is often the first voice of love we recognize. It comforts us in distress, teaches us right from wrong, and offers reassurance when we falter. There is something sacred in the way a mother lays down her life each day in small, hidden sacrifices—mirroring the Shepherd who lays down His life for the sheep.*

*And just as many of us first heard the voice of Jesus in our homes, through the witness of our mothers, so too have countless vocations been nurtured at the hearth of maternal faith. As we observe this World Day of Prayer for Vocations, we give thanks not only for those discerning the call to priesthood or religious life, but also for the women—mothers, grandmothers, godmothers, and spiritual mothers—whose faithful lives have helped many to hear the Shepherd's voice.*

*Today, may we take a moment to listen. Not to the noise of the world, but to the voice of Christ who calls us by name. And may we also give thanks for the maternal voices that have helped us hear His.*

*To all mothers: thank you. May God bless you with joy, health, and the peace that comes from knowing how deeply you are loved.*

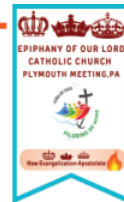

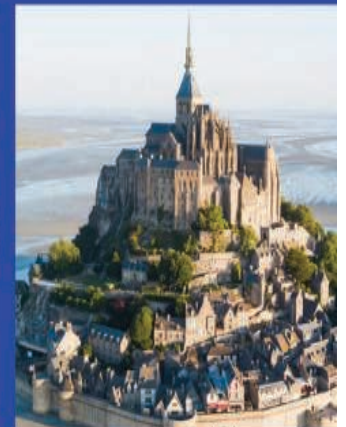

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

**Matrimony**

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
