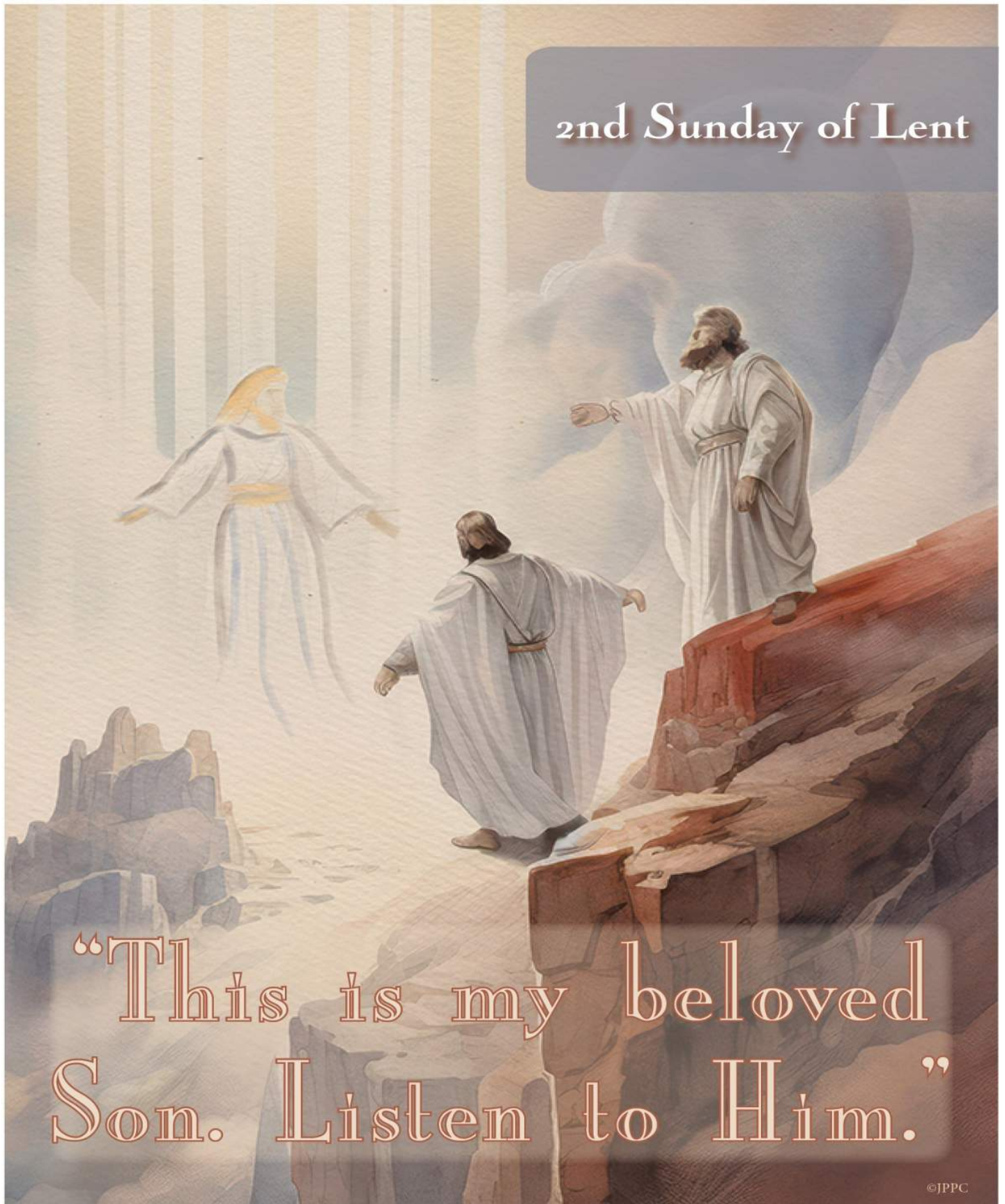

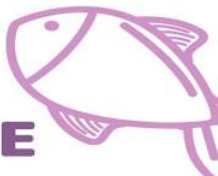

## LENTEN FASTING & ABSTINENCE



All Catholic fourteen years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat starting on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Catholics between the ages of eighteen and fifty-nine are obliged to fast starting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The fast means taking only one full meal, and if necessary, two light meals that together would not make a full meal. Nothing is taken to eat between meals except water.

The laws for fast and abstinence do not apply to people who are sick, or those who need to eat at certain times for health reasons (to take medicine, while expecting, etc.).

Those who cannot fast are encouraged to do some other act of penance on those days.


