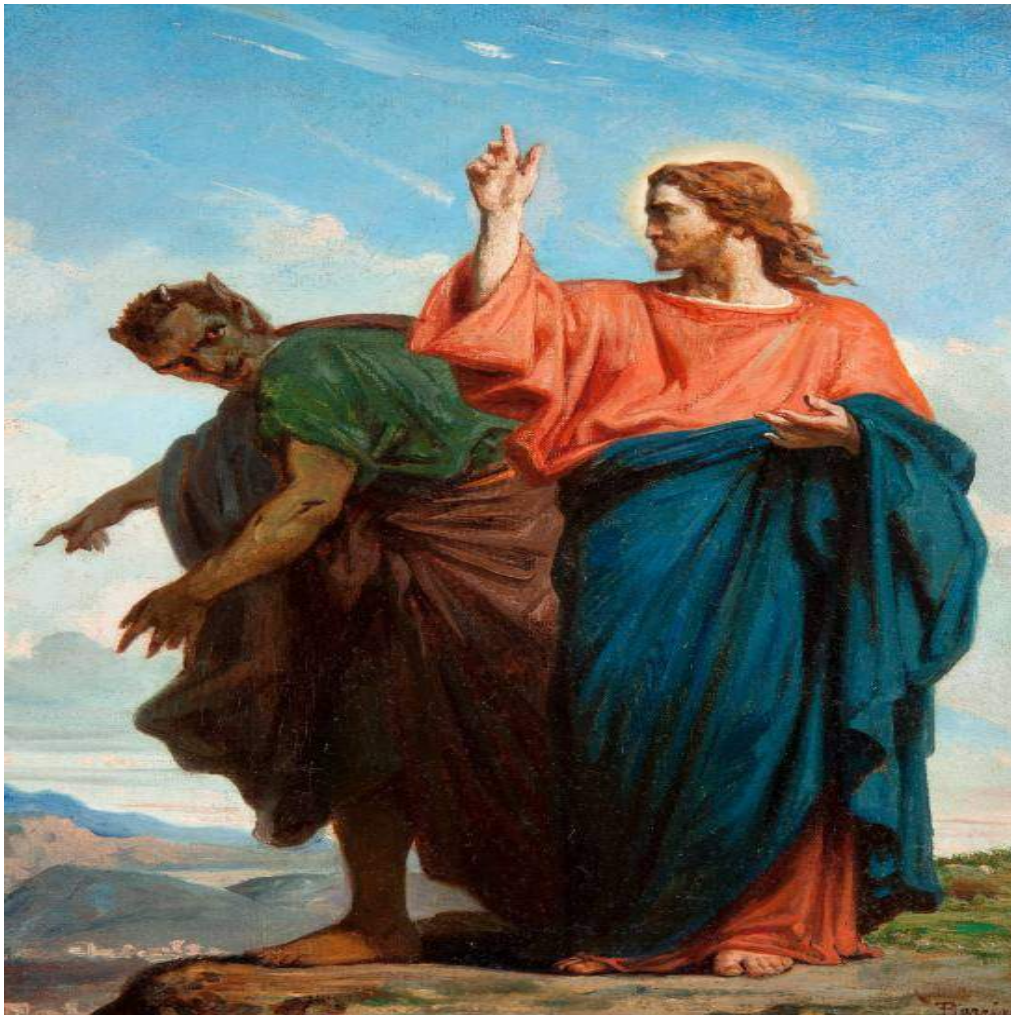

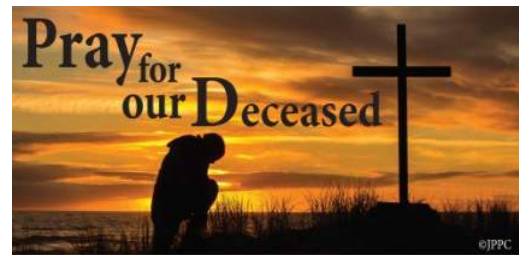

DEVOTIONS FOR LENT

Fasting

Catholics ages 18-59 should eat one full meal and two smaller meals on Good Friday.

Catholics are encouraged to fast on other weekdays of Lent. Fasting means eating only one full meal and two smaller meals that don't add up to a full meal.

Abstinence

Catholics ages 14 and older should not eat meat on Good Friday, and all Fridays during Lent.

Other Practices

Participate in prayer, such as the Stations of the Cross, the Rosary, and Scripture study.

Participate in daily Mass; Serve those in need; Give to the poor; Avoid needless television, video games, internet use and social entertainment.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed on the Wednesdays in Lent at 1:15 PM and 7:00 PM in Saint Monica Upper Church.

FROM THE MIND OF FATHER KELLEY

THE MOST BLESSED SACRAMENT

There are, of course, seven sacraments. There is one that we call “The Most Blessed” above the other six - it is Holy Communion.

Last year we began having our first communicants receive kneeling and on the tongue. This is an option that has been lost over the years. I think that it is important to know the history of our change from kneeling to standing as well as receiving in the hand.

In 1969, Pope Saint Paul VI issued a little-known document titled: “Memoriale Domini:” an instruction on the manner of receiving Holy Communion. In this document the Pope reaffirms the one and a half millenia practice of receiving Communion directly on the tongue. In 1977, however, after a heated debate, the bishops of the United States voted and on 17 June 1977 received dispensation to allow communicants to receive the Holy Eucharist in the hand.

In 1967, the Sacred Congregation of Rites promulgated “Eucharisticum Mysterium” allowing the faithful to receive either standing or kneeling.

In 2002, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (UXCCB) obtained a particular norm for the United States which required standing for the reception of Holy Communion but stated that communicants should not be denied Holy Communion because they kneel (General Instruction of the Roman Missal #160).

All this is to point out that the communicant has the justifiable option of either standing or kneeling and receiving on the tongue or directly in the hand. (More on the reverent way of receiving Communion in the hand next article).

While it is no surprise that I am of a traditional bent, for me personally, when I receive the Holy Eucharist, I receive on the tongue and kneeling. That is merely my personal option. However, when it comes to the first time for receiving the Blessed Sacrament, we will follow the practice done at our cathedral for first communicants and have them receive kneeling and on the tongue.
