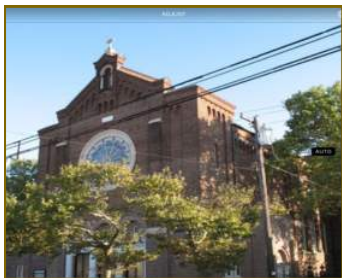

## FROM THE MIND OF FATHER KELLEY

### THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS

All during Lent we traditionally pray the Stations of the Cross. The origins began in the Holy Land with pilgrims visiting the Via Dolorosa (street of sorrow or way of sorrow) in Jerusalem. This is the path Jesus walked on Good Friday.

Although there is no written evidence, Tradition holds that the Blessed Virgin visited these sites daily. After Christianity was legalized by the Emperor Constantine in 312 AD, pilgrims traveled to the Holy Land to do just as the Blessed Virgin had done some 300 years before.

The Prophet Mohammad (Founder of Islam) was born in the year 572. In 622, he established the first Islamic state at Medina in Arabia. From there Muslim armies expanded and by 637, despite the efforts of the Crusaders to preserve the Holy Sites, Jerusalem fell to the Muslims. On the site of Solomon's temple in Jerusalem (which was destroyed by the Romans in 70 AD) a mosque was built. This mosque is called "The Dome of the Rock." This is the site where Muslims believe Mohammad ascended to heaven. The mosque stands to this day (I have visited it).

This conquest rendered the Holy Land unsafe for Christian pilgrims. As a result, interest grew in reproducing the holy sites for those who were no longer able to travel to Jerusalem.

So, to make a long story short, monks (mainly Franciscans) designed artistic renditions of the places in Jerusalem. (As a side note, the Stations are not the artwork - the Stations are the wooden crosses on the top or side of each of the Stations) and so, in praying the Stations, we not only are engaging in an ancient devotion but are in a sense, travelling to the Holy Land without having to board a plane.
