THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY FROM THE DESK OF DEACON KRIS VAN HEES

Today we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity – one of the central mysteries of our faith. Not a mystery that needs solving, but rather a mystery because it is a supernatural reality. In other words, it is something that is beyond the natural world that we live in. And it is therefore impossible for us to fully grasp. Likewise, it cannot be known without it being revealed to us because we are natural beings. And that is where the mission of the persons of the Most Holy Trinity, One God in Three Persons comes into play.

God the Father is the ultimate yet unseen source of all. He created all things with an infinite love. He is the author of the divine plan of salvation. But he remains hidden – a true mystery until he has been revealed to man.

God the Son is the visible image and exact representation of the Father. He was sent into the world by the Father and became man through the mystery of the incarnation. He reveals the Father to us, which is mostly clearly seen in the Gospel according to John. Jesus is constantly making the point that his authority comes from the Father – and this is also the central question posed to him by the Jewish authorities. They are also asking Jesus where his authority comes from (and unfortunately, refuse to accept the one and only true answer). It is through Jesus' revelation that we come to know the Father.

God the Holy Spirit is the active indwelling presence of the Father in us. Jesus promised that the Spirit would come to guide believers into all truth, reminding them of Christ's words and taking what is the Son's and making it known. The Holy Spirit reveals Jesus Christ, God the Son, to the whole world. It is also with the descend of the Holy Spirit – Jesus asking the Father to send to Spirit – that the Church is instituted.

And is where the Most Holy Trinity touches us and involves us in its mission. We are invited to participate in the plan of salvation. The Body of Christ on earth (the Church) reveals the Spirit at work in the world. Through the community, sacraments, and love of believers, the presence of the Holy Spirit becomes tangible, which ultimately points to the Son and the Father.

So there is a chain of revelation at work here... The Church reveals the working of the Spirit, who reveals the mission of the Son, who reveals the Father as the creator and author of the plan of salvation. This chain

reveals that God is not a solitary, distant figure, but a relational community of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The Church exists to continue this outpouring of divine love outward into the world.

May God, Heavenly Father, Incarnate Son, and Holy Spirit, continue to pour out his divine love in the world through his Church and may we faithful servants be worthy to be his instruments.

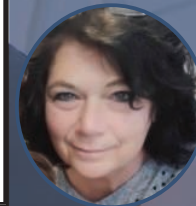

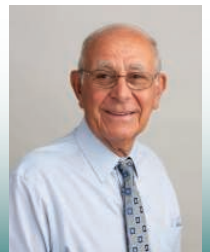
