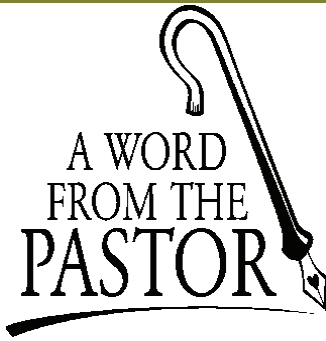

## **JUNE: MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART**

## **CONGRATULATIONS, GRADUATES!**

This Wednesday, June 3rd, 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation takes place at our Regional School of Holy Rosary. Likewise, at this time of year, there are many Graduations from Grammar School, High School and College. Our children and young people attend many different schools! We are very grateful that they all remain under the "umbrella" of Holy Saviour Parish. An interesting statistic: in our recent First Communion Class, about one third of those children attend Regional or other Catholic Grade Schools, and about two-thirds are home-schooled or attend Public Schools. In addition, we have a number of children who attend private, Catholic schools.

We wish all our children and young people, from whatever schools they are graduating, all God's blessings and we remind them, and their parents, to not be forgetful of God from Whom all blessings come.

## **SUMMER SCHEDULE**

As you know, over the years we have tried to make as few changes as possible in our Mass schedule. I am immensely grateful to Father Navit, Father Heron and Father Vinod for their assistance, and for being so much a part of our parish. However, Father Heron is retired, and Fathers Navit and Vinod have their primary responsibilities. It is especially difficult to find assistance on Saturdays during the summer. It is also the time of increased weddings, continued Funerals, vacation time, etc.

*Therefore, as we have done for a number of years now, beginning Saturday, June 13, up to and including the Saturday before Labor Day, there will be an adjustment in the Saturday schedule at Holy Saviour Church: There will be no morning Confessions from 8:30 to 9, and no 9am Mass. The Vigil Mass continues at 5:15pm and the Saturday afternoon Confessions will be heard from 4:30 to 5:00pm. (The Padre Pio Mass will be celebrated, as usual, on Saturday, June 6, with Confessions preceding).*

As always, I am grateful for your understanding and your devotion to the Parish!

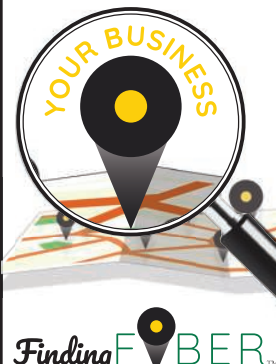
