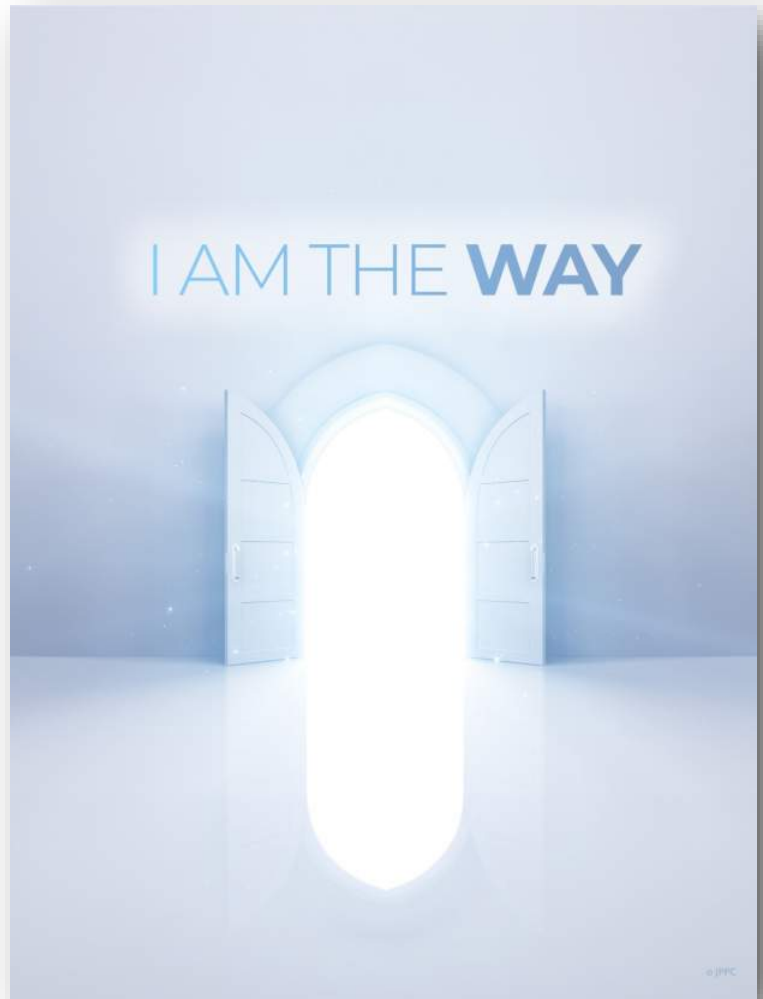

THE GOSPEL OF MATTHEW

Thursdays @ 6:30pm-8pm
April 23rd to May 28th, 2026

We invite you to join us in a Bible study on the Gospel of Matthew, which is the primary Gospel for our current liturgical year. The Gospel of Matthew is more than the first book of the New Testament—it is the key that unlocks the story of Jesus as the fulfillment of the Law, the Prophets, and the long-awaited Kingdom of God. In this 6-session program, using a video course from the St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology, Dr. Scott Hahn will lead us in exploring how Jesus is the new Moses and the promised Davidic King who came to establish God's Kingdom through the Church. Sessions will be held every Thursday evening, from 6:30-8 pm starting on April 23 through May 28 at the Parish Life Center.

We will use the Ignatius Catholic Study Bible Old and New which is available online on Amazon, St. Paul Center, and other retailers.

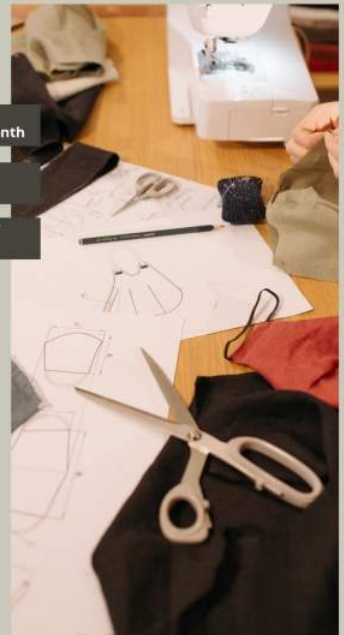

Faithful Reflections

Dear Friends,

In the Gospel reading this weekend Jesus tells us “Whoever has seen me has seen the Father.” “Seeing” Jesus requires from us the desire to be one with him in faith and love, to trust that he reveals himself to us and calls us to see the Father in his words, his works, and to hear his voice. That can sometimes be a stretch for us, especially if our hearts and our minds are filled with the cares and worries of this life.

Jesus tells us repeatedly, “Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me.” This of course is the answer but sometimes it is difficult to trust that everything will work out according to God’s plan but even there Jesus offers us the answer, “Jesus said to him, I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”

The belief that Jesus is the way and the truth and the life is something that should fill our hearts with hope and with peace. Trusting in him and believing in him is putting our faith into action, trusting and believing even when it is difficult or dry. Jesus is the answer to our prayers; he is the way by which we see the Father. May our belief in him and his love sustain us in all things.

Faithful Reflections by Rev. Leonard Peterson

Any holder of seaside property knows that he or she has an obligation to respect the laws of shifting tides and occasional flooding. Neglecting either would prove to be foolish. So, he or she wisely makes sure the house is built solidly on rock, or perhaps on strong piers rising from the sand high enough to escape damage.

The whole strategy can easily become a metaphor for our spiritual lives, which must have a firm foundation upon Christ as our Rock, or on the strong piers of belief and trust, enabling us to rise above any contemporary threat or cultural deviation.

Our modern Western culture follows upon two millennia’s worth of threats to belief—a veritable stockpile of weapons, if you will—arising either from within or, at other times, from without the Church. From within, we can cite heresies that have plagued our community from its earliest days. God chose great saints, holy men and women, who used their prayer-driven insights and called upon heroic courage to fight these enemies of truth and lead the Church to new positions of strength. Often, they were obvious errors, like denying Christ’s divinity despite the Scriptural proclamation.

Today, I believe the threats are more subtle. They cloak themselves in comfortable disguises so that they look just like good common sense. Take materialism, for example—the misguided belief that being rich is the way to true happiness. Most of the people in the advertising universe seem young and energetic and bursting with happiness as they hold a certain product in their hands. Or perhaps they are more mature and tell us about investments that have made them comfortable and worry-free. Just one false tenet of a fake joy.

So we must be vigilant. We must know Christ’s teachings, which are the same as Church teachings, and hold to them when these “storms” come along. As the old hymn reminds us, time and time again: “The Church’s one foundation is Jesus Christ the Lord.”

I don’t understand electricity, but I’m no fool. I’m not going to sit around in the dark until I do. The same is true of salvation. I don’t fully understand how God could become man, how He could die as the basis for my forgiveness, or how He could give you and me a new life. But only a fool would ignore such a great opportunity to build a life upon it just because he didn’t understand it.

God love you and give you His Easter peace.

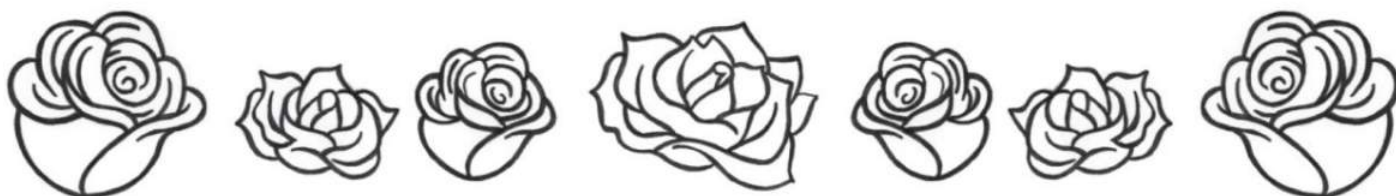

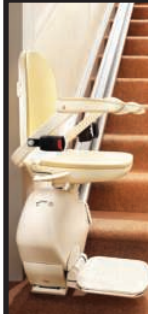
