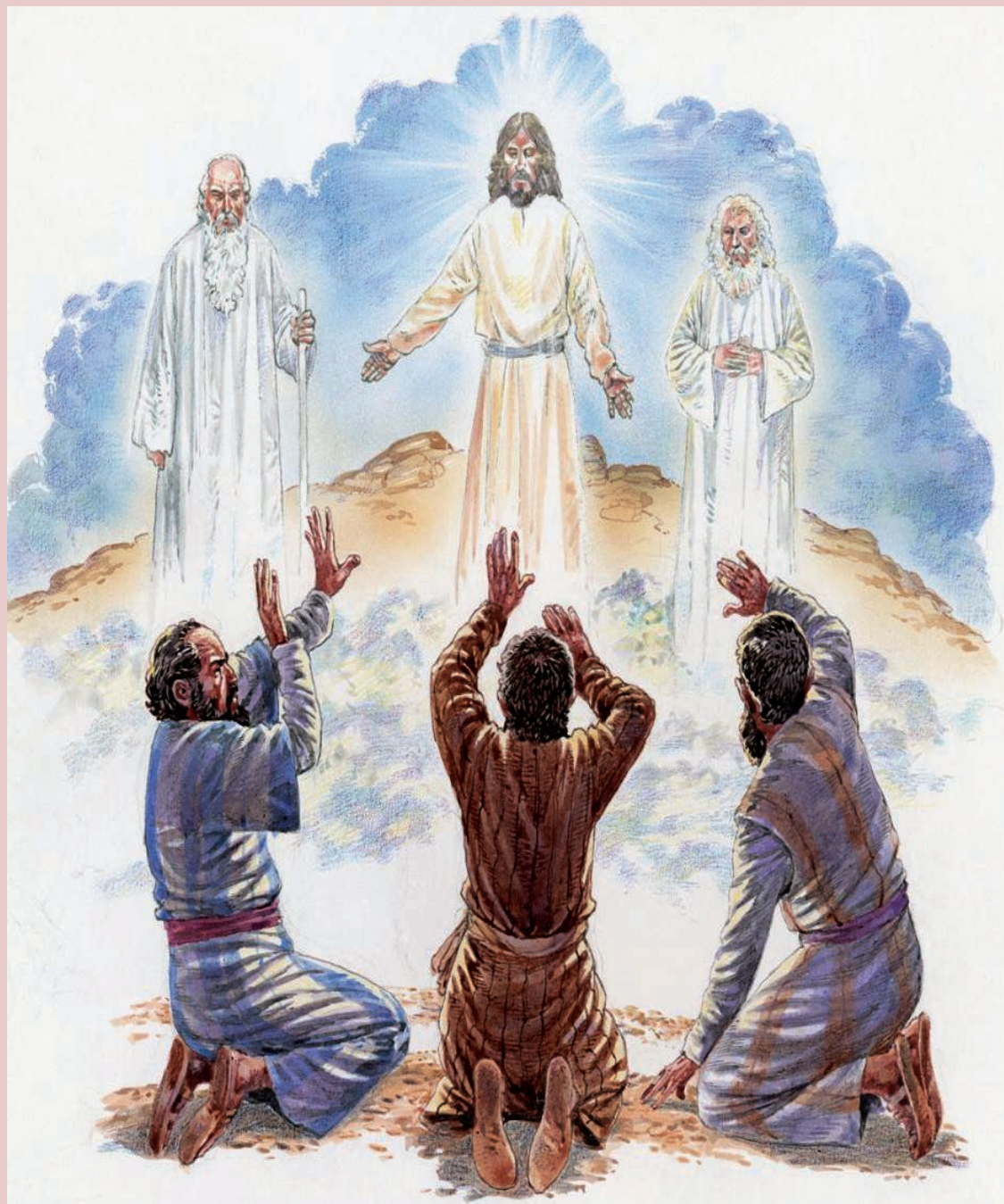

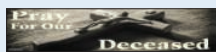

What was a 'building block' moment for you at Saint Pius X? One of my fondest memories at St. Pius was in fourth grade with Sister Bernadette Mary. Sister Bernadette saw my strengths and built my confidence in ways that made sense to me. That was an instrumental building block to growing confidence that enabled me to compete against the toughest of competition.

How did your foundation at Saint Pius X shape who you are today? I learned more life lessons while at St. Pius than I can remember. Caring for the elderly is always a special memory. In fourth through eighth grades I rode my bike to deliver holiday cards to the homebound elderly. This character building created my mantra of "treat others as you would like to be treated."

What are you building in your life now, and how does your faith influence it? My Catholic education has shaped my values, work ethic and sense of purpose. It has enabled me to empower young female athletes by instilling principles of integrity, resilience and service. With faith as my anchor I feel the confidence to navigate challenges with grace and perseverance.
