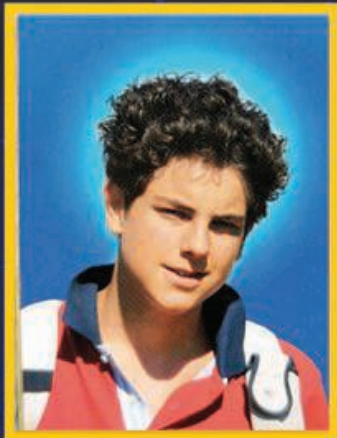

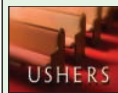

Building the Future: Brick By Brick Project Updates



Phase II is scheduled to begin this summer. The scope of this phase includes repairing and/or removing, and replacing the brick walls on half of the classrooms and offices on the Lawrence Road side of the building, as well as portions of the auditorium entrance wall and return wall. Additionally, the original windows in these areas will be replaced. Originally estimated at **\$1.1 million**, through discussions with our engineers and vendors, we have successfully reduced the cost to **\$758,103**.



Phase III is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2026. This phase includes repairing or removing and replacing the brick walls on the remaining classrooms and offices, as well as the far auditorium and cafeteria wall. Additionally, it will involve replacing the remaining original windows and installing a new roof for the entire building. The initial budget for this portion of the project was **\$2.1 million**, which has been reduced to **\$1.95 million**.

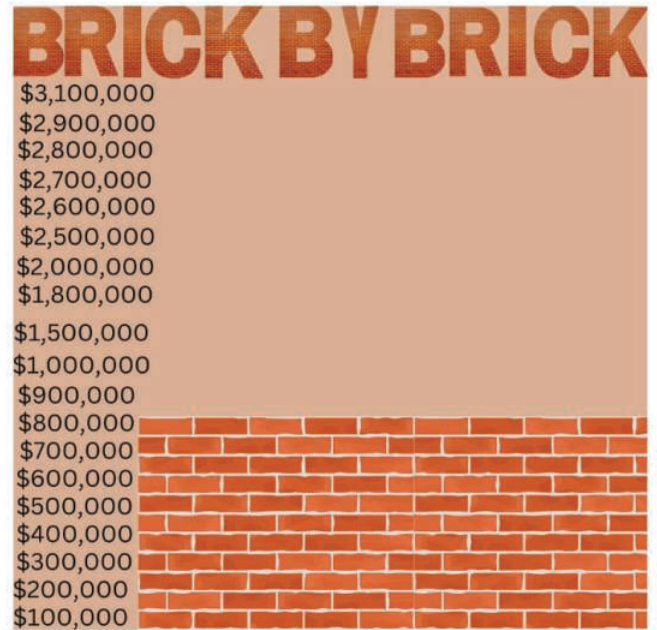

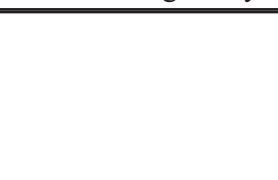
