Dear Brothers and Sisters,

“Repent and believe in the Gospel.”

We continue our journey through Lent. **How are we doing?** The Gospel on that first day of Lent tells us to pray, fast, and give alms.

Remember that **Jesus calls us friends and wants to be our companion on the journey. Do we let him?**

We were happy to celebrate this Saturday morning the Lord’s mercy, forgiveness, and love. **Ninety of our young parishioners**, along with their parents, family members, and friends celebrated the **Sacrament of Reconciliation (Penance)** for the first time. A joyful and happy day for our parish.

This coming Saturday, March 7th, we will welcome Bishop John J. McIntyre—one of our auxiliary bishops—to our parish. **Bishop McIntyre is coming to St. Pius X** to preside over our **Confirmation Mass**. This Saturday, **65 of our young parishioners will receive the Gift of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation**.

Our parish congratulates all who received Reconciliation for the first time. We also congratulate all who will receive Confirmation. An added thanks to all parents, guardians, grandparents, teachers, staff—all who encouraged and guided these boys and girls to their Sacraments.

Writing about two of our seven Sacraments, reminds me of another of the gifts Jesus left for us—**the Sacrament of Matrimony**.

Our parish celebrates this gift with a special Mass in mid-February every year. Earlier this month we had 62 couples gather to celebrate their Sacrament of Matrimony.

On the Archdiocesan level, there will be a celebration of this Sacrament on **Saturday, May 2, 2026 at our Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter & Paul at 5:15pm**. A special blessing will be offered for those celebrating milestone wedding anniversaries (1, 5, 25, 30, 50+ years). Everyone, including friends and family, are welcome and encouraged to attend. 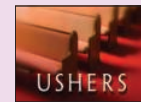
