FOOD FOR THE POOR

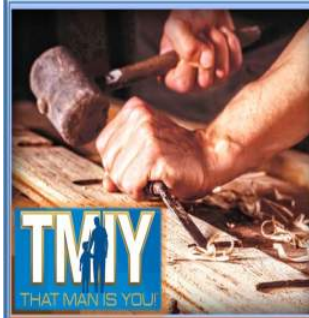

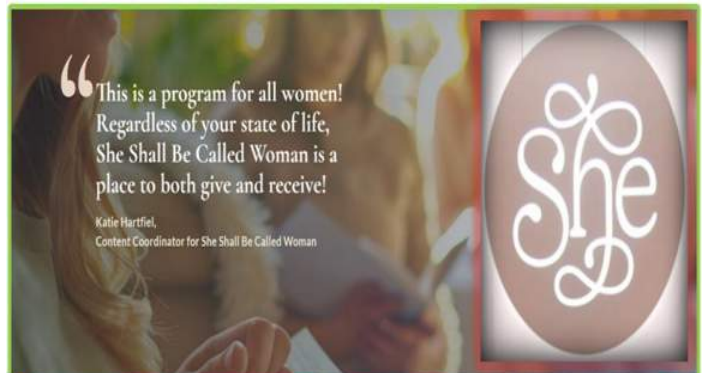
