Parish Registration and Membership

It is important that all Catholics within our boundaries are registered and active members of our parish. Sometimes, changes in registration are necessary. If you have moved out of your parental home (not just for college) or are living with your parents and are over 18, you should register. If you are new to the area, you should also register with the parish. To register, please **contact the rectory** for an appointment.

Sacramental Information

Anointing of the Sick: Contact the rectory should you or someone you love require to be anointed prior to admission to the hospital. You may also ask a priest after Mass for this beautiful Sacrament.

Baptism for children is celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sundays at 1:00PM (except during Lent). Pre Jordan meeting (parental instruction) is required prior to Baptism, they are the 1st Wednesday of every other month. Contact the rectory to schedule a Baptism. At least one of the godparents must be a practicing Catholic who can obtain a Certificate of Eligibility from their home parish.

Confirmation Sponsors must be at least 16 years old, have received Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confirmation, attend Mass regularly, and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the Catholic Church. These requirements are the universal law of the Church. If you wish to be a Confirmation sponsor in another parish, you will need a Certificate of Eligibility from our parish office.

Eucharist for the homebound can be visited by a priest and Holy Communion can be brought to a homebound person each Sunday. Please contact the rectory to schedule visits.

Eucharistic Adoration is every Wednesday following the 8:15am Mass until noon, unless a funeral is scheduled.

Marriage: Couples planning marriage should contact the rectory at least nine months in advance of their wedding date. Weddings are not celebrated during the season of Lent.

Reconciliation is every Saturday 2:30-3:30PM

The **Parish Religious Education Program** (PREP) umbrellas RCIA (Adults), CCD (Children attending non-Catholic schools), as well as those who were Baptized into a valid Christian faith but wish to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through the reception of the Sacraments. It also covers children of age and adults who have been Baptized Catholic but are lacking in one or more other Sacraments.

Knights of Columbus (Mary, Queen of Angels) is open to all men who are at least 18 years old and a practicing Catholic. Our Knights do many good works within our parish, in our school, and through their outreach. For information, please contact Barry Rusch at 215.852.8350

Join us for the Rosary

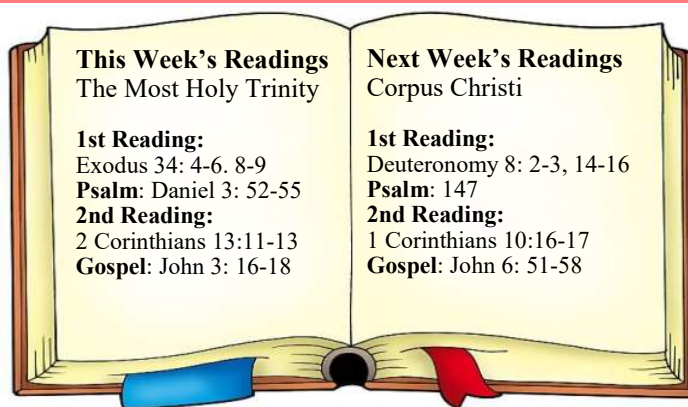

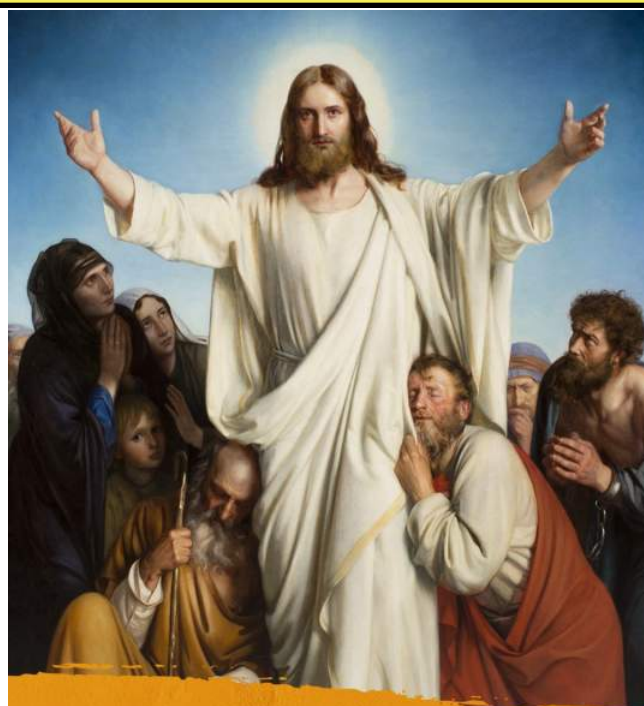
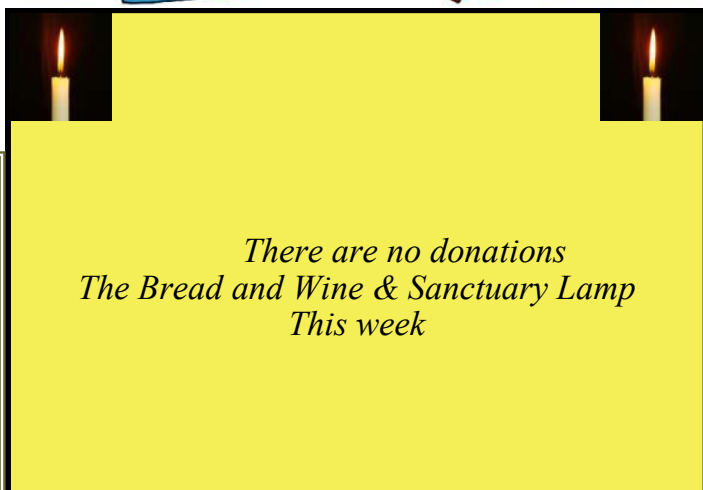

Pro Life Corner

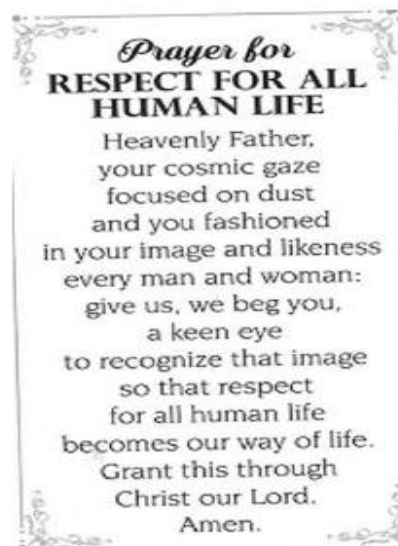
