Did you know that the word "Trinity" is not found in the Bible? Yet all Christians believe in the mystery of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Holy Trinity is a theological term that emerged in the second century to describe the incomprehensible mystery of God.

We come to know God because Jesus revealed the mystery of God through his words and actions. The life, death, Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus teach us about the inner life of God, and the sending of the Holy Spirit deepens that understanding. Yet Revelation gives us only a glimpse of the fullness of God. Scripture says it best: "Your ways, O Lord, are far beyond our understanding."

When we gather for worship, we nourish that eternal life by listening to God's Word and receiving the Blessed Sacrament. God desires us more than we can imagine. May our hearts be filled with gratitude for the blessings we receive each day.

As we journey through life, we are invited to trust in the mystery of God's plan, even when we do not fully understand it. In times of transition, change, and even sadness, we remember that God continues to guide his people with love and wisdom. United in the family of God, we trust that the Lord is leading us where we need to be.

*Saint of the Month*

**Saint Dymphna**



Saint Dymphna is remembered as a 7th-century Irish virgin martyr who became the patron saint of mental health, known especially for her courage in fleeing her father's harmful intentions and ultimately dying for her faith and purity.

Saint Dymphna was born in Ireland to a pagan chieftain and a Christian mother. After her mother's death, Dymphna took a vow of chastity and secretly embraced Christianity. Her father, overcome with grief and mental instability, sought to remarry—but when no woman matched his late wife's beauty, he turned his attention toward Dymphna, who closely resembled her mother. To escape his intentions, she fled to what is now Geel, Belgium, accompanied by her confessor, Father Gerebernus.

In Geel, tradition says she lived quietly and even helped care for the poor. Her father eventually tracked her down. When she refused to return and submit to his demands, he killed Father Gerebernus and then beheaded her. She was about fifteen years old.

After her death, devotion to Dymphna grew, especially in Geel, where a long-standing tradition of compassionate community care for people with mental illness developed around her legacy. She is honored today as the patron saint of mental health, those suffering from emotional distress, and victims of abuse.

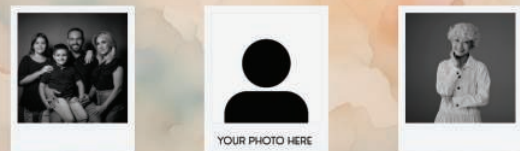
