DIOCESAN EVENTS:

ADULT CONFIRMATION: Bishop Schlert will offer the Sacrament of Confirmation for adults on Pentecost Sunday, May 24, at the 11 AM Mass at St. Joseph the Worker Parish, Orefield. This ceremony is for those adults (18 years and older) who were baptized in the Roman Catholic Church, received their First Holy Communion, are catechized, but have never been confirmed. DIOCESAN 33-DAY EUCHARISTIC CONSECRATION: This diocesan-wide initiative invites the faithful to consecrate themselves to the Holy Eucharist. SANCTUARY RENOVATIONS: Bishop Schlert has developed a plan for some minor sanctuary renovations with the installation of a parapet, which is an elevated railing to be installed on both sides of the platforms of the sanctuary in front of the cathedra and the ambo. There is an ongoing concern about the blind corners where the steps meet the elevated floor. The modifications of a column-supported railing will complement the existing marble tones of the sanctuary. The coloration will match the existing marble as it was extricated from the same quarries in Italy as the current sanctuary flooring. This renovation project is a diocesan initiative. There will be no financial obligation on the part of the parish for this project.

The work is to be done on the weekdays during the weeks of May 18-29. In order to accommodate the work, please note the following:

DAILY MASSES (Monday through Friday) will be offered in the Msgr Ott meeting room, which will be set up as a temporary chapel. Following the 8 AM daily Masses, the "Msgr Ott Chapel" will be locked and remain off limits to all meetings and public visitation throughout the renovations.

DAILY CONFESSIONS will be available in the PAC in a private and well-marked location.

WEEKEND MASSES (Saturday morning, Sunday Masses and Memorial Day) will be offered in the church. Confession will be available on Saturday afternoons in the church as usual.

FUNERAL LITURGIES will be offered at neighboring parishes according to request and availability.

WEDNESDAY EVENING DEVOTIONS on May 20 and 27 will not be held during the renovation times. The Blessed Sacrament will be removed from the church and all public access to the church will be off limits for safety reasons.

BIBLE STUDY SESSIONS (May 18 and Tuesday, May 26) will be held in the Bishop Thompson Meeting Room. Please enter via the office entrance on Turner Street.
