This year the USCCB will consecrate the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 12, the Feast of the Sacred Heart, to coincide with the 250th anniversary of the nation. **At Holy Ghost parish we will precede the Consecration with a Novena that will be prayed after 8:00 am daily Mass from June 3 through June 11.** On June 12, the Feast Day, Fr. Pendergraft and the Priests of our parish will pray the Act of Consecration after all Masses at Holy Ghost, additionally, we will have a Holy hour of Adoration to the Blessed Sacrament after 8:00 am Mass.

First Friday Adoration will follow the **8AM Mass on Friday, June 5**, with Benediction at 6:10PM, followed by Mass at 6:30PM.

Sports at the Shrine of Good St. Anne (175 Nazareth Pike, Bethlehem), led by Father Florance, will be held on **Friday, June 5, 5-8PM** and continue throughout the summer. This weekly activity is intended for children and older youth, but everyone is welcome.

From the Pages of a Gentler Time *Weekly wisdom from "The Correct Thing for Catholics" (1891)*

We return again to the font this week, for our 1891 author has a little more to say on the matter.
This week: **The Correct Thing at Baptism** (*continued*)

- 1 For sponsors to make a present to their godchild, expensive or trifling, as their purse or inclination may dictate.
- 2 For sponsors to know that they are obliged in conscience to look after the religious requirements of the child, if it is in danger of not being properly instructed.
- 3 To have a christening dinner if the parents wish to do so, to which may be invited the parish priest and the sponsors, and such intimate friends as are desired.
- 4 To dress the girls in white and blue, and boys in brown during the first seven years of their lives to show that they are consecrated to the Blessed Virgin.
- 5 To put a little medal or some other sign of Christianity around the child's neck, and always keep it there.
- 6 For sponsors to place their right hands upon the child at the pouring of the water in the act of baptizing.
- 7 To remain after baptism until the record, with correct names, is made by the priest.
- 8 To have the written permission of the rector, if some grave reason impels one to have his child baptized outside of the parish.
- 9 For a mother to receive the blessing of the church after childbirth (the ceremony is called churching).
- 10 To bring a beeswax candle for use during the blessing, or to make a contribution to the altar if a candle be supplied by the church.
