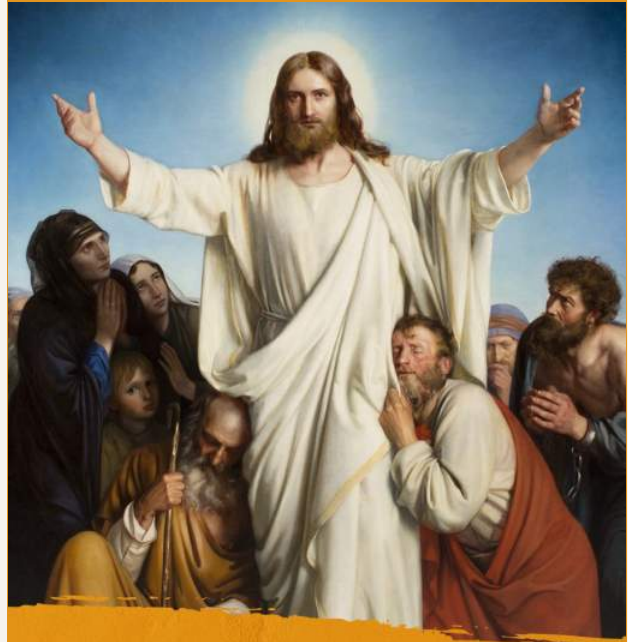

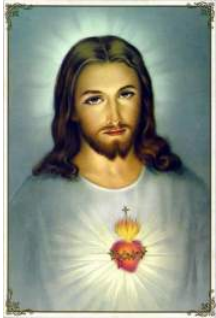

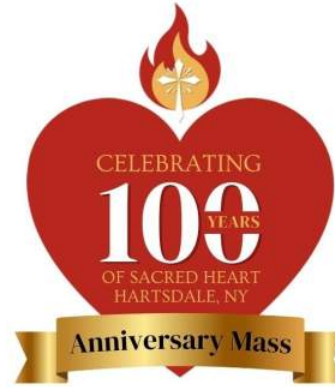


Father's Day remembrance

Please note that if the headcount exceeds 400 we will have to ticket the event. Tickets will be given to the first 400 who RSVP, so please RSVP early!

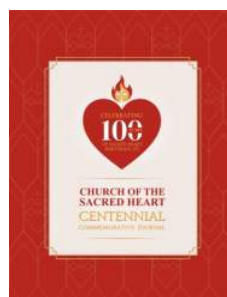

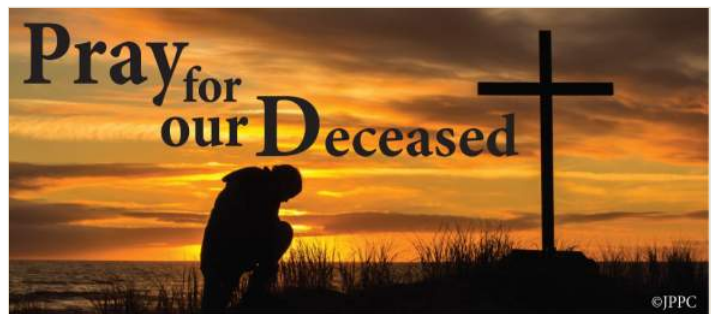

Consecration of the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus



On June 11, 2026, as part of the celebration of the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the U.S. bishops will consecrate the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Parishes around the country are encouraged to join the bishops in celebrating the consecration of our nation to the Sacred Heart.

Our parish of Sacred Heart in Hartsdale will incorporate the consecration into our 100th anniversary Mass on Sunday, June 14th. We hope that you and your families will join us for this extra special Mass.

Individuals are also encouraged to join the U.S. Church in praying the Sacred Heart novena from June 3-11. This novena draws its daily devotions from the Litany of the Sacred Heart. Each day reflects on the wisdom of saints and pontiffs on the Sacred Heart and offers opportunities for prayer and action, framed by Pope Francis' encyclical *Dilexit Nos* (He Loved Us) and Pope Leo XIV's apostolic exhortation *Dilexi Te* (I Have Loved You).

Additionally, families are also encouraged to enthrone the Sacred Heart of Jesus in their homes and consecrate their families to the Sacred Heart. This tradition is rooted in the revelations of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and the 12 Promises he would grant to those who venerated his Sacred Heart. One promise was that he would bless every place where an image of his Heart is exposed and honored.



By enthroning the Sacred Heart, families commit to living according to Christ's teachings and embrace a way of life rooted in his love, mercy and blessings.

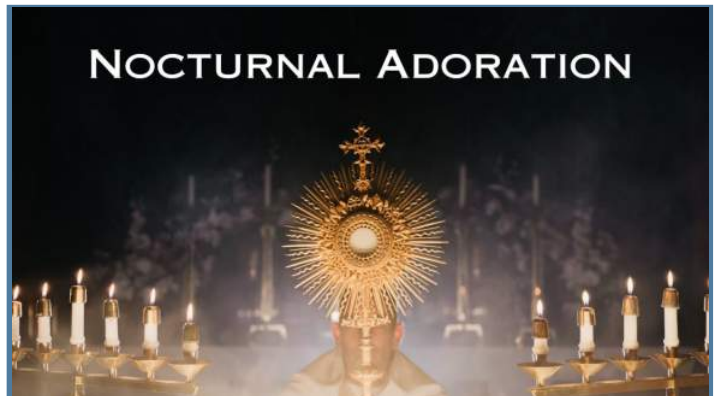


Eucharistic Procession June 7th

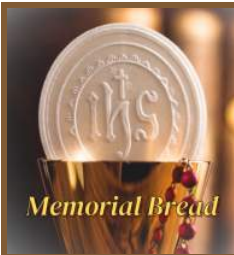

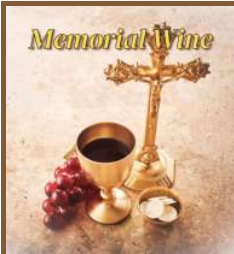


NOCTURNAL ADORATION
