PASTOR'S LETTER

Continued Happy Easter!

Some stuff to note this weekend:

- This is Good Shepherd Sunday. The Church always devotes this Fourth Sunday of Easter to Jesus as our Good Shepherd. We get to remember that Jesus is not just our teacher or exemplar, but our Shepherd: a Protector who is drawing His scattered sheep to Himself so that He may lead us to His True Pastures.
- This weekend is also what our Archdiocese has labeled "Called by Name" Sunday, a campaign to encourage and nurture vocations to the priesthood. Cardinal Dolan has invited parishioners to write the names of young men or teens who exhibit a heart for service to the Church upon the cards which you will find at the Masses this weekend, which can then be dropped into the collection box. For myself, perhaps the greatest "pitch" I can make regarding vocations to the priesthood is to say that, eight years into my own priestly life, I am nothing short of overwhelmed with gratitude for the gift God has given me by inviting me to share in the priestly work of his Son.
- This month of May is the month of Mary. Immediately following the (5/11) 11am Mass, our First Communicants will lead us in a procession to crown the outdoor statue of the Blessed Mother. This day and this month, let's be very intentional about our relationship with our Blessed Mother: to take time to be with her, to bring our needs to her, to give her the opportunity to look upon us and to see us looking towards her, as any mother would want. Jesus himself has given her to us as a precious gift he wants us to have.
- Speaking of mothers, today is Mother's Day. I wish every blessing to the mothers of our parish and extend to you my thanksgiving for your witness of love to the Church and to the world.
- Join me in praying for our students receiving Confirmation this Friday (5/16). We are looking forward to welcoming Bishop Bonnici for this beautiful day.
- Some June events to be aware of: 1) our Parish Block Party, immediately following the 11am Mass on 6/8 – I hope you can join us for this Pentecost celebration! 2) a Eucharistic Procession for Corpus Christi on 6/22.
- Summer vacations are fun to plan, but there is no better vacation than taking time to be with the Lord – to "come away by yourselves to rest a while" in his company, as Jesus tells us. I encourage you to consider joining me and fellow parishioners for our parish retreat – a quiet, prayerful, 40 hours to be with the Lord in the retreat center at Graymoor, half an hour's drive north. Taking time for these experiences always bears fruit. Sign up on the website or by calling the office.
- At the time of this writing, the papal conclave is in process. Whatever stage the process has reached by this weekend, we all are one in prayer with the universal Church at this time, asking for the Spirit's outpouring and guidance.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday the risen Christ consoles us: "My sheep hear my voice; they follow me." What fills Christ's disciples with joy and the Holy Spirit is this voice, which is identical with life. As with the converts whom Paul and Barnabas urged "to remain faithful to the grace of God," our happiness lies in our faithfulness to the tender voice of the Shepherd. For this Shepherd is also the Lamb who lives to wipe every tear from our eyes. With Saint Gregory of Nyssa we say: "How could I not love you, who have loved me so much as to lay down your life for the sheep whose shepherd you are? There can be no greater love than this, to lay down your life for my salvation."
