PASTOR'S LETTER

In one of his essays, C.S. Lewis reflects on the journey of Christ: his descent from his Divine life in the Trinity into the flesh of our world as he takes on our human nature, his death on the cross and three days in tomb, followed by his resurrection and ascension – and compares that journey to the acrobatic feat of a diver:

One has the picture of a diver, stripping off garment after garment, making himself naked, then [leaping] in the air, and then down through the green and warm and sunlit water into the pitch black, cold, freezing water, down into the mud and slime, then up again, his lungs almost bursting, back again to the green and warm and sunlit water, and then at last out into the sunshine, holding in his hand the dripping thing he went down to get. This thing is human nature....

Indeed, Jesus stripped himself of the garment of his divinity, entered into the gloom and pain of our world, swimming all the way to the very pits of human existence with its suffering and death to retrieve humanity.

And what we celebrate today is the “turning point” of that dive – the moment when Christ, having found the “object he had lost” in the mud turns back towards the light of heaven, treasure in hand. In forty days, we will celebrate his Ascension, when he bursts back into the sunlight of heaven, our human nature now bathed in the light of his divinity.

He did that great dive to find the treasure he had lost on the ocean floor. That treasure is all of human nature, as Lewis says. It is the treasure of humanity. But it is also the treasure of you. Your soul is the treasure he sought. He has claimed you for his own. And if you let him, he will bear you in hand all the way to the heights of heaven.

Truly, this day, we have every reason to join every soul redeemed by him and say, Alleluia!

LITURGY NOTES

Jesus is risen! As Pope Francis said, “This message resounds in the Church the world over, along with the singing of the Alleluia. He remained two days in the tomb; but his death contained God’s love in all its power, released and made manifest on the third day, the day we celebrate today: the Easter of Christ the Lord. The words heard by the women at the tomb are also addressed to us: Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. Death, solitude, and fear are not the last word. There is a word that transcends them, a word that only God can speak: it is the word of the Resurrection.” Christ has made good on all he promised. He is truly risen.

Entrance Antiphon I have risen, and I am with you still, alleluia. You have laid your hand upon me, alleluia. Too wonderful for me, this knowledge, alleluia, alleluia.

Collect Prayer O God, who on this day, through your Only Begotten Son, have conquered death and unlocked for us the path to eternity, grant, we pray, that we who keep the solemnity of the Lord’s Resurrection may, through the renewal brought by your Spirit, rise up in the light of life. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

Communion Antiphon Christ our Passover has been sacrificed, alleluia; therefore let us keep the feast with the unleavened bread of purity and truth, alleluia, alleluia.
