## PAROCHIAL VICAR'S LETTER

*The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God  
and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.*

These words, from the Second Letter to the Corinthians, sometimes appear as an extended version of the greeting during the Introductory Rites at Mass. We are baptized, and we pray, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. This is our great privilege: *to acknowledge the Trinity of eternal glory, and to adore the Unity, powerful in majesty* (Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, Collect).

Many things compete for our attention. Many things seem more important, or at least more urgent, than our Trinitarian faith. Who can really devote time to Trinity Sunday, when there are so many wars, disasters, and tragedies going on? And besides, thinking about the Trinity is hard. Can't we just get the basics and leave the Trinity to professional theologians (like Fr. Paul)?

*Can we leave it alone?* No. The Father sent the Son into the world to give us *eternal life*. That means *his own life* – a share in the eternal communion of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Our invitation to enter into God's life is about way more than just "getting the facts right." It means entering into frequent conversation with the One God, the Three Persons. When a man and a woman prepare for the shared life that is marriage, their love drives them to get to know each other, to spend time with each other. The same thing happens with us and God.

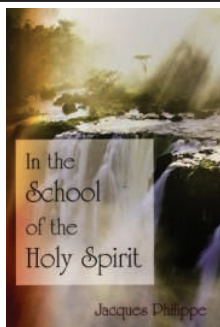
*But what about everything else going on in the world?* From a natural standpoint, there's very little we can do for the world. What will benefit the world, what is most urgently needed in the world, is true holiness – for each of us to be transformed by the truth that *God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life*. This transformation is impossible without the aid of the Holy Spirit.

During the Easter season many of you attended and enjoyed Fr. Paul's "Christology 101." This class gave us a chance as a parish to ponder deeply the mystery of Jesus Christ: who he is and what he did for us. If that time helped even just one person draw closer to Jesus (and I'm sure it did!), then it was time well spent.

Fr. Luke has invited me to do a follow-up program devoted to the Holy Spirit, sometimes called the "Forgotten Person" of the Trinity. So, I'm very happy to announce **Holy Spirit 101**, a brief (two-part) series on who he is and what he does for us. This will be in the parish hall at **7pm on Thursday, June 18 and Thursday, July 2**.

We'll be aided in this series by reading *In the School of the Holy Spirit*, a short and approachable book by Fr. Jacques Philippe. Copies are available for purchase at the church entrance. I hope that this series will lead many of us more deeply into communion with the Holy Spirit as we prepare for eternal life.

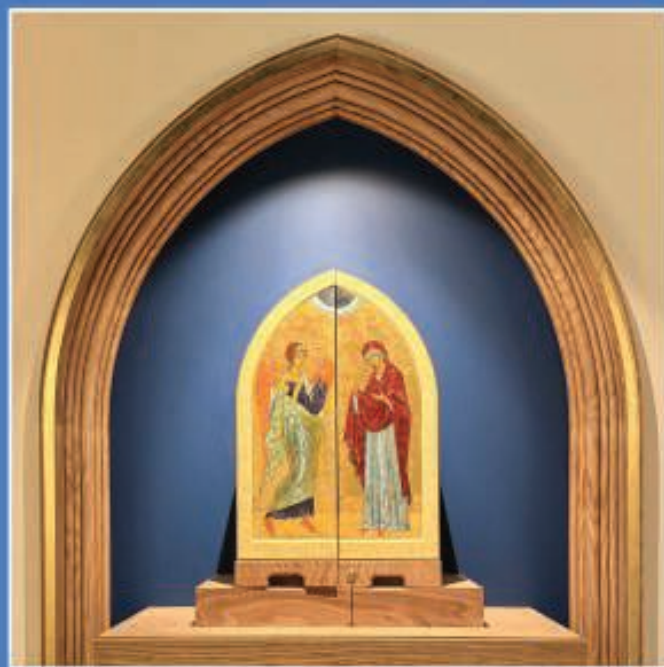

# ADORATION CHAPEL OF THE SACRED HEART

## WHAT IS ADORATION?

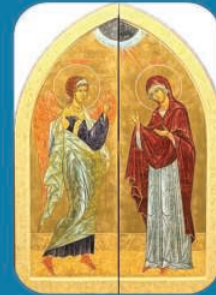
Adoration is a time of prayer in the visible presence of the Eucharist, with the Eucharist placed in a *monstrance* so that it can be seen.

## WHY GO?

There is no greater joy and peace than coming to know and love Christ Jesus – and He is truly present in the Eucharist! By spending time in Adoration, we learn to enter into Jesus' presence and grow in our knowledge and love of Him.

## WHAT DO YOU DO?

- ◆ Rest in Jesus' presence
- ◆ Listen for Jesus' voice
- ◆ Speak to Jesus what is on your heart
- ◆ Meditate upon Jesus by reading the Gospels
- ◆ Pray the Rosary
- ◆ Quietly pray however the Holy Spirit moves you!



## OUR GOAL: 24/7 ADORATION

- ◆ We want our Chapel to be open for Perpetual Adoration. This can begin once we have 2 people signed up for each 1-hour time slot each week.
- ◆ We will reach our goal of Perpetual Adoration gradually, filling up portions of the week step by step.
- ◆ Adorers sign up for a weekly 1-hour time that they will attend to every week.
- ◆ Once every time slot of the week has committed adorers the Adoration Chapel will be 24/7 so that you can come by for Adoration anytime!

## LITURGY NOTES

**The Catechism teaches that “by sending his only Son and the Spirit of Love in the fullness of time, God has revealed his innermost secret: God himself is an eternal exchange of love, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and he has destined us to share in that exchange” (221). “The three persons are one truth” (Saint Augustine). By pondering the truth of the Trinity, we also realize the full truth of ourselves: By his gift of faith, God has made his own life available to us even now. “The complete Trinity dwells in us” (Father Marie-Michel Philipon, O.P. ) God reveals the fullness of his very self to us that we “might not perish but might have eternal life,” and that we might be received as his own.**

**Entrance Antiphon** Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

**Collect Prayer** God our Father, who by sending into the world the Word of truth and the Spirit of sanctification made known to the human race your wondrous mystery, grant us, we pray, that in professing the true faith, we may acknowledge the Trinity of eternal glory and adore your Unity, powerful in majesty. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

**Communion Antiphon** Since you are children of God, God has sent into your hearts the Spirit of his Son, the Spirit who cries out: Abba, Father.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** *Through the Anointing of the Sick, Christ 1) unites our sufferings to Himself so that they may bear spiritual fruit with Him and 2) unites us our sufferings to the communion of His Body, the Church.*

- This Sacrament is an important help for those facing serious illness, advanced age, or surgery due to one of these. Please contact the Office to speak to a priest about receiving this Sacrament.

Please also let us know if you or a family member is nearing death. Call the Emergency Line if it is after hours: (914) 340-4486.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY:** *Through this Sacrament, a husband and wife enter into a covenant of life and love, becoming an image of the love between Christ and His Church.*

- To be married in the Catholic Church, please contact the Office at least six months in advance so that we can help prepare you to receive this Sacrament.

- Please also reach out if you are already civilly married but not married in the Church, or if you have any questions about a previous marriage. One of our priests will be happy to meet with you and assist you.

**BAPTISM** Please visit our website or call the parish office.

**HOLY COMMUNION FOR HOMEBOUND** If you want to receive Holy Communion at home, please contact the parish office.

**GLUTEN INTOLERANT?** If you have a gluten intolerance and would like to receive a low-gluten Host at Communion: please utilize the baptistry side Communion line and inform the minister that you would like to receive a low-gluten host.

## MUSIC MINISTRY

The recessional hymn for this weekend's celebration of the Most Holy Trinity is the traditional hymn of praise, **Holy God We Praise Thy Name**. It was written in German in 1771 by Ignaz Franz, and is a paraphrase of the Latin Christian hymn, **Te Deum**.

The original German, *Grosser Gott, wir loben dich*, was translated to English by Clarence Augustus Walworth in 1858. Translators are hymn writers too and contribute greatly to the library of hymns used in Christian worship. These writers have the challenge of translating the words, while honoring the content with language that fits the metrical rhythm of a pre-existing tune. Clarence Walworth considered a vocation as an Episcopal priest, but followed his father's desire for him to become an attorney. He passed the bar, but soon abandoned law, moved to New York and became a Roman Catholic priest. He is one of the founding members of the Order of Paulists.

We thank these two Catholic priests for the memorable melody and theme of one of the most popular hymns in dioceses around the world.

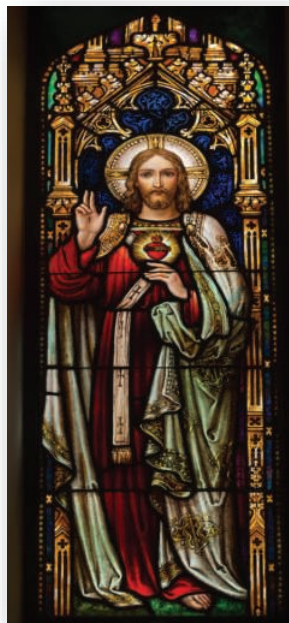
