SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM - Baptisms are celebrated every second and fourth Sunday at 12:00pm. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class. Please call the Rectory to register for a class so that we have adequate materials. Godparents and children are welcome to attend.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE - In order to accommodate our own Parishioners, only Parishioners of St. Peter (Bride or Groom) will be able to be married in St. Peter Church. Couples planning to marry at St. Peter are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time first. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana Conferences as mandated by the Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of six months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding date. For Pre-Cana reservations call 663-1373. Only Parish Musicians are permitted for Wedding Masses. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - The priests may be called at any time day or night for the Sacrament of the Sick. Furthermore, the priests will be happy to visit the Sick with Holy Communion upon request.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION - Tuesday 12 Noon-12:30pm; Saturday 2:30-3:30pm and 6:30-7:00pm

FUNERALS - The proper form of Church burial for a baptized Catholic is the Mass of Christian Burial, not a service at a funeral home. Viewings in the Church are not permitted. Funeral Masses are scheduled at 10:00am. No eulogies in church, and only Parish Musicians are permitted for Funeral Masses, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

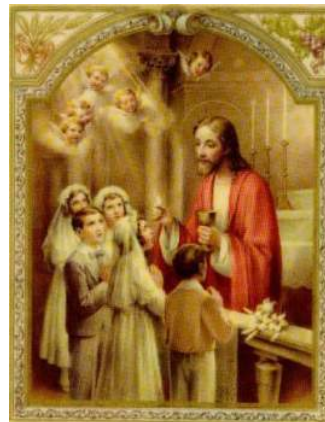

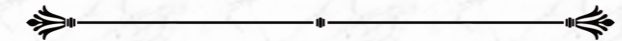

Banns of Ordination to the Diaconate



The Most Reverend Joseph A. Williams, D.D. announces that he intends to ordain Mr. Nickolas B. Naticchione to the Sacred Order of Presbyter on Saturday, the 16th day of May, 2026 at The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, 642 Market Street, Camden, New Jersey.

The faithful of the Diocese of Camden are asked to pray for this man and for the young men of our diocese who are being called by God to service in the Church. At the same time the faithful are obliged to reveal impediments to sacred orders, if they know of any, by contacting their pastor before the ordination in accord with the norms of cc. 1043 and 1051.2 of the Code of Canon Law.

Mary Immaculate, patroness of the Diocese of Camden, intercede for these men and for an increase in vocations to the priesthood here in South Jersey.

Support the Parish Through a Qualified Charitable Distribution

Another way to support our parish while potentially receiving tax benefits.

As we continue to ask for your prayerful support of our parish, we would like to share another way of giving that may also offer tax benefits for some parishioners.

A **Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)** allows individuals age **70½ or older** to make a gift directly from their **traditional IRA** to a qualified charity, such as our parish. If you are required to take a **Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)** from your IRA, you may choose to have part or all of that amount sent directly to the church. **The amount given will count toward your RMD and may be excluded from your taxable income**, which may help reduce your taxes.

To qualify, the donation must be **sent directly from your IRA custodian to the charity**. The maximum amount that may be given in this way is **\$11,000 per year**. If you are interested in making a Qualified Charitable Distribution to support our parish, please contact your **IRA custodian or financial advisor** to request the appropriate form.
