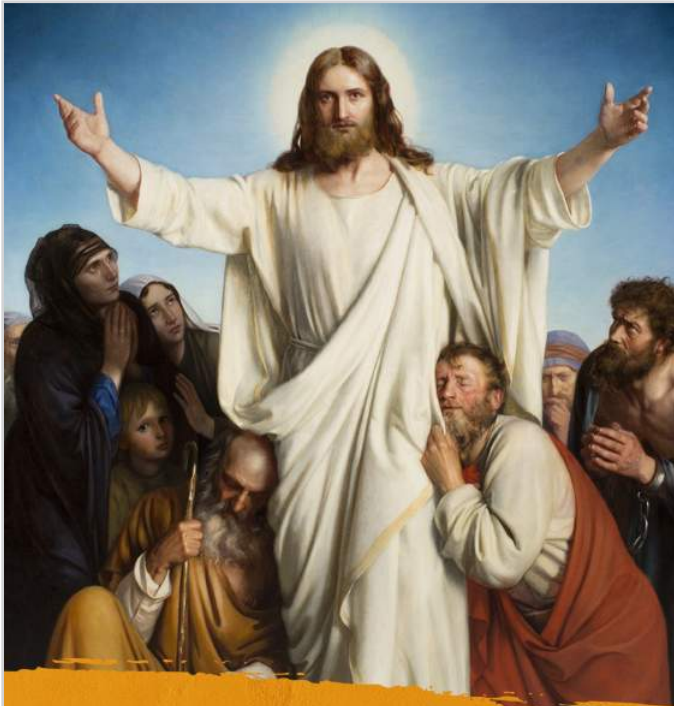

CLERGY CORNER



Dear friends, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, let us begin our reflection with the Sign of the Cross: *“In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.”*

Long before we learned the traditional prayers such as the Our Father and the Hail Mary, all of us were taught to bless ourselves in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, touching our head, heart, and shoulders. From our childhood, we were introduced to God as the Trinity. Whenever we make the Sign of the Cross, we profess our faith in the Triune God. There is something deeply meaningful about learning this prayer so early in life because, as infants, we were baptized in the name of the Father,

and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

The doctrine of the Holy Trinity is the greatest mystery of our faith. It is beyond the full capacity of human understanding. Fifteen centuries ago, Saint Augustine of Hippo was reflecting on the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

As he walked along the beach near Hippo, he noticed a young boy carrying water from the ocean with a small bucket and pouring it into a tiny hole in the sand. Augustine asked him, “What are you doing?” The boy replied, “I am trying to pour the whole ocean into this little hole.” Augustine smiled and said, “That is impossible.” At that moment, Augustine realized that he himself was attempting the impossible, trying to fit the infinite mystery of God into the limited understanding of the human mind.



Sacred Scripture and the Tradition of the Church teach us to believe that God is Triune: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, three distinct Divine Persons, co-equal and co-eternal, yet one God. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches: *“The Trinity is One. We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit... each of them is God whole and entire”* (CCC 253). One of the masterpieces of the Church’s liturgy is the Preface for Trinity Sunday, which beautifully proclaims: *“For with your Only Begotten Son and the Holy Spirit, you are one God, one Lord: not in the unity of a single person, but in a Trinity of one substance.”*

In Scripture, we find signs and hints of the mystery of the Holy Trinity. *“Let us make man in our image”* (Gen 1:26). The plural words “us” and “our” suggest a communion within God. The Hebrew name *“Elohim”* is plural in form, yet refers to the one God, hinting at plurality within unity.

In Genesis Chapter 18, Abraham encounters three visitors but addresses them as one Lord. We see this as an image of the Trinity. Likewise, in Isaiah’s vision, the angels cry out, *“Holy, Holy, Holy,”* which we understand as praise to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Jesus clearly reveals the mystery of the Trinity when He said, *“The Father and I are one”* (Jn 10:30), and He commands His disciples to baptize “in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19). Notice that Jesus says “name,” not “names.” God is one, yet exists in three Divine Persons.

The Holy Trinity is a mystery of perfect unity and perfect love. Through Scripture, we come to know the Father who created us, the Son who redeemed us, and the Holy Spirit who guides and sanctifies us. The Triune God is a communion of perfect love, inviting us into that divine life. As we celebrate this great feast, we are invited not to understand God completely, but to trust Him, love Him, and live in communion with Him whose love is deeper than the ocean itself.

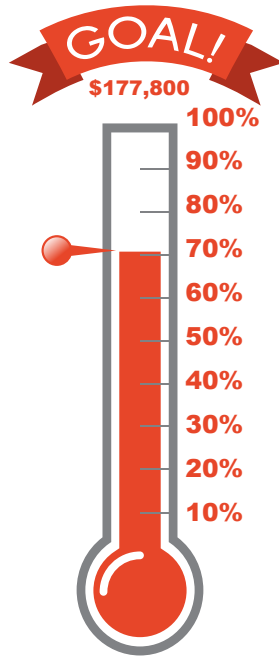

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Each week in the bulletin, we will be featuring parishioners' testimonials of attending daily Mass. I'm grateful to each one of them for their willingness to share how daily Mass has impacted their lives, and I pray that it will inspire you as well. God bless, Fr. Sanjai

About 12 years ago, I started listening to Lighthouse Catholic CDs (now Augustine Institute) which made me realize how clueless I was as a Catholic, and I wanted to be better. I started praying the rosary and praying more. I completed my 3 days Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on July 16, 2014. After this Fr. Sigrifido Troche (RIP) started preaching during his Sunday homilies that Sunday Mass is an obligation and we should try to go to Mass during the week when it's not an obligation but rather to visit and worship God because we love Him. After a few homilies, it convinced me to go to Mass an extra 1-2 days. I remember it was January 2015 and I made it my New Year's Resolution. It started as an intention to go an extra few days but soon I was going every day. I felt that it sets the day right when I start with Mass in the morning. It made me better able to deal with the stress of work, and family life, made me more patient and less judgmental of other people. I think it made me a better mother and wife. The Lighthouse Catholic CDs started the process because it made me want to learn more and have the faith like the speakers. The Consecration to the Blessed Mother changed everything for me. She is so gentle in correcting me, guiding me and helping me do better. -Anonymous

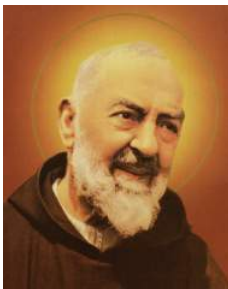
