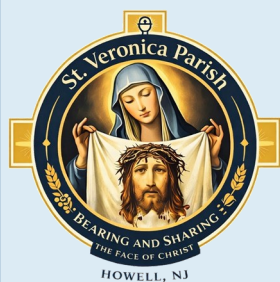

WE ARE CALLED TO SANCTIFY

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace and Joy to you and your loved ones!

If someone asked you to explain the Holy Trinity in detail, many of us might suddenly check our watches, refill our coffee, or discover an urgent reason to be somewhere else.

One God in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Clear as mud, right?

And yet, the Holy Trinity is not meant to give us a theological migraine. It is meant to reveal something beautiful and life-giving: God is love.

Before there was creation, before there was time, before there were emails, deadlines, and traffic on Route 9, there was love—the Father loving the Son, the Son loving the Father, and the Holy Spirit as the living communion of that divine love.

Which means this: we were made for love, not isolation; for relationship, not endless scrolling; for communion, not merely sharing a room while everyone stares at their own glowing screen.

The Trinity is less a math equation to solve and more a divine invitation to live differently. Love shared. Love given. Love received.

So perhaps the challenge this weekend is not to explain the Trinity perfectly (even priests approach that with caution!), but to reflect it in the way we live: by being a little kinder, forgiving a little faster, giving a little more generously, and perhaps surviving Route 9 with slightly more grace and considerably less commentary from behind the steering wheel.

As we celebrate this great feast, may the love of the Father, the grace of the Son, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit fill your hearts and homes.

BEWARE OF EMAIL SCAMS



Dear Parishioners,

Please be advised that scammers sometimes use the names of clergy or staff from St. Veronica Parish in emails, text messages, or other communications in an attempt to deceive parishioners.

These fraudulent messages may appear to come from a priest, deacon, or parish staff member and often ask for gift cards, money, donations, personal information, or urgent assistance.

For your protection, please always check the sender's actual email address—not just the display name. Scammers can make a message look legitimate at first glance, but the return email address often reveals that it is not from St. Veronica Parish.

If you ever receive a suspicious message claiming to be from one of our clergy or staff, do not respond, click any links, or send money or information. Instead, please contact the parish office directly to verify the communication.

A good rule of thumb: When in doubt, check it out.

Thank you for your vigilance and help in protecting our parish community.

WHAT IS A QCD?

Quite a few of St. Veronica's parishioners make their yearly donation to the parish through the QCD option. A **qualified charitable distribution (QCD)** is a tax-free donation from your individual retirement account (IRA) to a qualified charity. You must be age 70½ or older to make a qualified charitable distribution. A qualified charitable distribution, QCD, is not included in your taxable income and helps satisfy your annual Required Minimum Distribution.

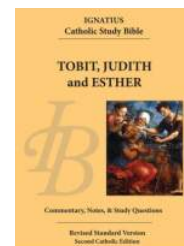


SUMMER BIBLE STUDY

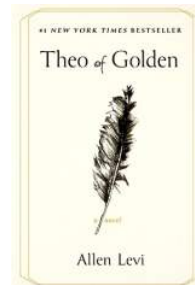
