Instead of a Reflection on the Gospel reading, I'd like to provide a personal witnessing as we kick off our Lenten Message Series.

As we begin this Lenten season, I find myself reflecting on the deep wounds I've carried these past few years, and how our upcoming message series, *"Broken, Yet Healed: Finding God in Our Pain,"* resonates with me personally. Many of you know that I lost my son Chris in 2021 to a painful liver disease, and almost exactly two years later, I lost my other son Jonathan to Stage 4 melanoma cancer. Jonathan's suffering was so intense that he even considered ending his life to escape the pain. These experiences shook my faith and left me grappling with questions that I still don't have answers to.

I've struggled to understand how a loving God could allow such suffering, and there were times when I grew angry and distant from God. I even took a sabbatical from the church and the ministries I've served in, trying to process the grief and confusion. I'm still working through it all, still seeking answers.

But in the midst of all this pain, I've found glimmers of hope. Conversations with our clergy, reading, and connecting with others who've experienced similar struggles have been sources of comfort and healing. It's clear to me now that every one of us carries a burden - a wound that we struggle to make sense of. And while the answers aren't always obvious or immediate, I've learned that speaking to God, even when it feels like He's silent, is the first step toward healing.

As we explore this Lenten series together, my prayer is that we can all find peace, even in the face of our deepest questions, and draw closer to God in the process.

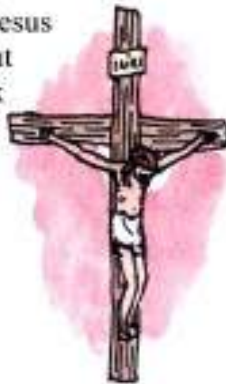
Looking at Jesus

Nicholas Gives Back

Shortly after birth, Nicholas was diagnosed with Cooley's Anemia, a life-threatening blood disorder that required him to receive blood transfusions every 3 weeks to stay alive. The only approved cure for Cooley's Anemia is a Bone Marrow Transplant. Nicholas was blessed to find a matching donor and received a bone marrow transplant in 2019. He is now considered cured by his transplant team since he no longer requires blood transfusions to survive!

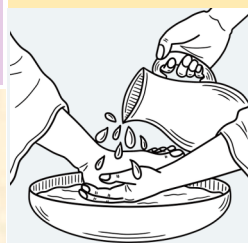
