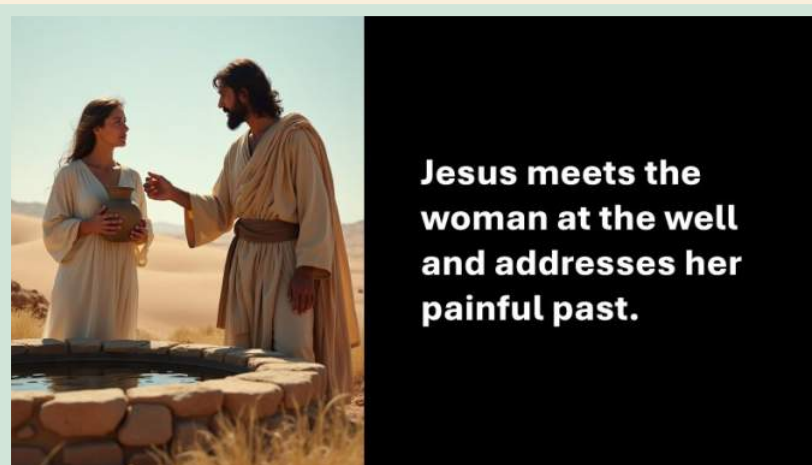

### BROKEN RELATIONSHIPS

We are a large family; I am number 5 of 6 girls and 2 boys. Growing up on a tobacco farm gave little time for school related recreational activities. Our recreation took place as a family involved in the parish community. I left home at 17 and married at 19. After about 10 years, the marriage began to fall apart and finally did after 15 years.

When a marriage falls apart, there can be fault on both sides as was the case with us. I was young and didn't have much of a support system at the time. There were decisions made that may have changed the course, but we were too far apart.

Telling my family was one of the most difficult things I had to do. You see, no one in the family was divorced. I knew I would be ostracized by family and somehow it would be all my fault. One day on my way to work I thought it might be easier to pull in front of a tractor trailer and slam on the brakes than it would be to tell the family. I had never felt so alone in my life. I realized that it was all new to them and they needed time to process it, but it was still difficult and would take time. If not for my faith in God to help me through this, I surely would have taken a different course. Some people turn away from their faith in tough times; I turn toward mine.

### THE SECOND HURDLE AND HURT

After we divorced, a family friend and priest encouraged me to go through the process of an annulment. The process was awful. Me alone in a room with a tape recorder and a priest. There was no compassion; I left humiliated, in tears and told not to discuss our conversation with anyone. There were days when I was pretty sure God had abandoned me, but I let my faith in God and the power of prayer to see me through this experience. My mantra, "If God brings you to it, God will bring you through it". God will never abandon you, don't abandon Him. Just know you are never alone. I'm sure some of you have had a similar experience.

# Water...



In today's first reading, the Israelites in the desert are thirsty and ask Moses for water. So God tells him to strike a big rock with his staff and water comes out. In the Gospel reading, Jesus tells the Samaritan woman that He can give her living water so that she will never be thirsty.

Water is a symbol of life. In the first story the people in the desert would have died if they didn't get water. Now Jesus gives us His life, which is grace. We receive it especially in Holy Communion. This is the living water that He is talking about. Our souls need His grace to stay alive.



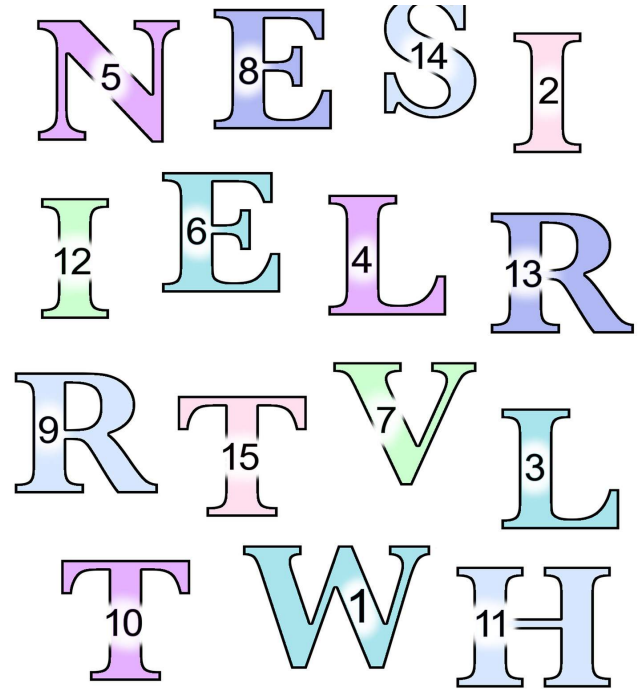
When you have a drink of water, think about how your body needs water to stay alive, and how your soul needs God's grace. Saying a prayer is kind of like giving your soul a little drink!

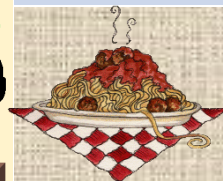

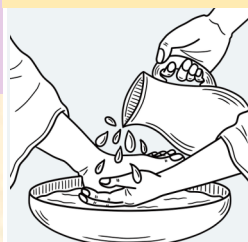
