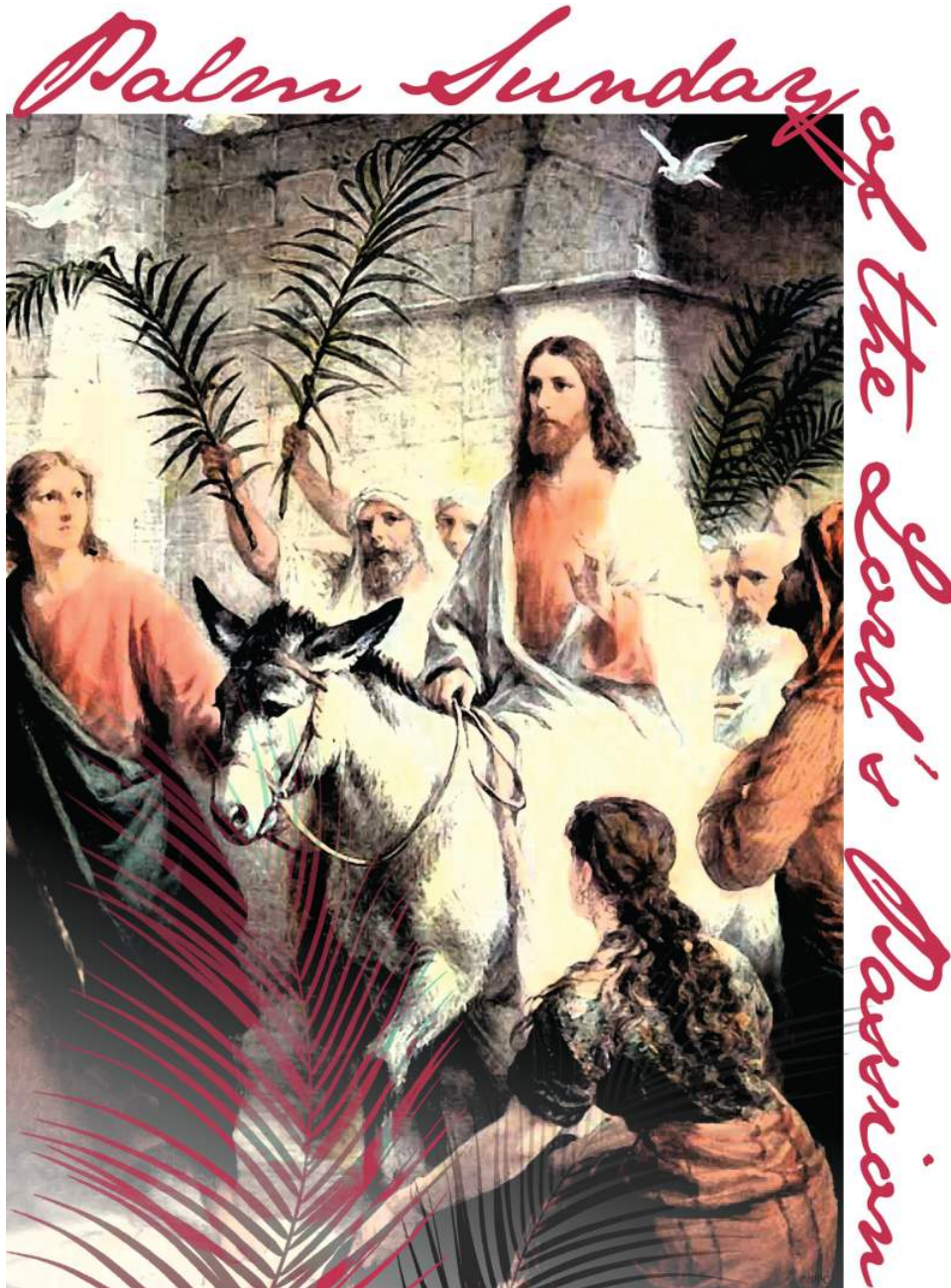

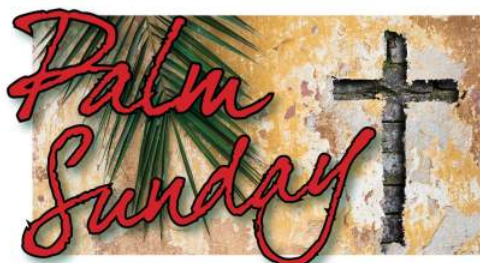

The Sunday after Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday, is a day of extraordinary graces - a complete outpouring of His Mercy upon all who approach Him with great trust and expectant faith. Jesus gave an extraordinary promise of grace to ALL who would receive Holy Communion in the state of grace on Divine Mercy Sunday, saying they would "obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (Diary 699. - St Faustina's Diary). That means not only is the person forgiven for any mortal or venial sins they may have committed, but also that they will receive a complete remission of the punishment due for sin - that is, no Purgatory. How great is Divine Mercy!



To receive God's Mercy is as easy as **ABC**.

**A** - Ask for God's Mercy - We must repent - Be sorry and go to confession before DMS.

**B** - Be Merciful to others, out of love for Him - through our actions, words and prayers.

**C** - Completely Trust in God's Mercy. Do not dwell on the past or fear the future. Trust that God wants what is best for us. We show that trust by obeying His Commandments.

God's Mercy is so great that even the worst sinner in the world can be saved from Hell if he asks for it. But even our little sins hurt Jesus, so we all need to ask God for mercy.

### Sacraments and Policies

#### Baptism

Held on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month following the 11:30 Mass. Godparents must obtain a Letter of Eligibility from their home parish(es). A one-hour Baptism class is required if the baptism is for the parents' first child. Both parents must attend, and Godparents are strongly urged to attend. Class is held at the Rectory at 7:00pm on the 1st Wednesday of the month. Parents must call the parish office to confirm their attendance at the class.

#### Marriage

Arrangements must be made 1 year prior to the marriage date. Please contact the Rectory.

#### RCIA

The process of prayer, study, and spiritual formation that prepares adults for entrance into our faith. Please contact Deacon Kevin Heil.

#### Parish Membership

Registering in our faith community is the best way to become involved in our parish! When you register, you become part of our vibrant Catholic community whose members support one another in living out Jesus' Great Commission to be his evangelizing disciples. Visit or call the office to register.

#### Certificates of Eligibility

In order to receive a certificate, you (not your parent) must be a practicing Catholic, and registered in the parish. If married, you must be married in the church. You must attend Mass regularly. Use of weekly offering envelopes will tell us you are attending regularly.

#### Care of the Sick

Contact the parish office to arrange home visits with the Eucharist for the sick and elderly. Also, contact the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.
