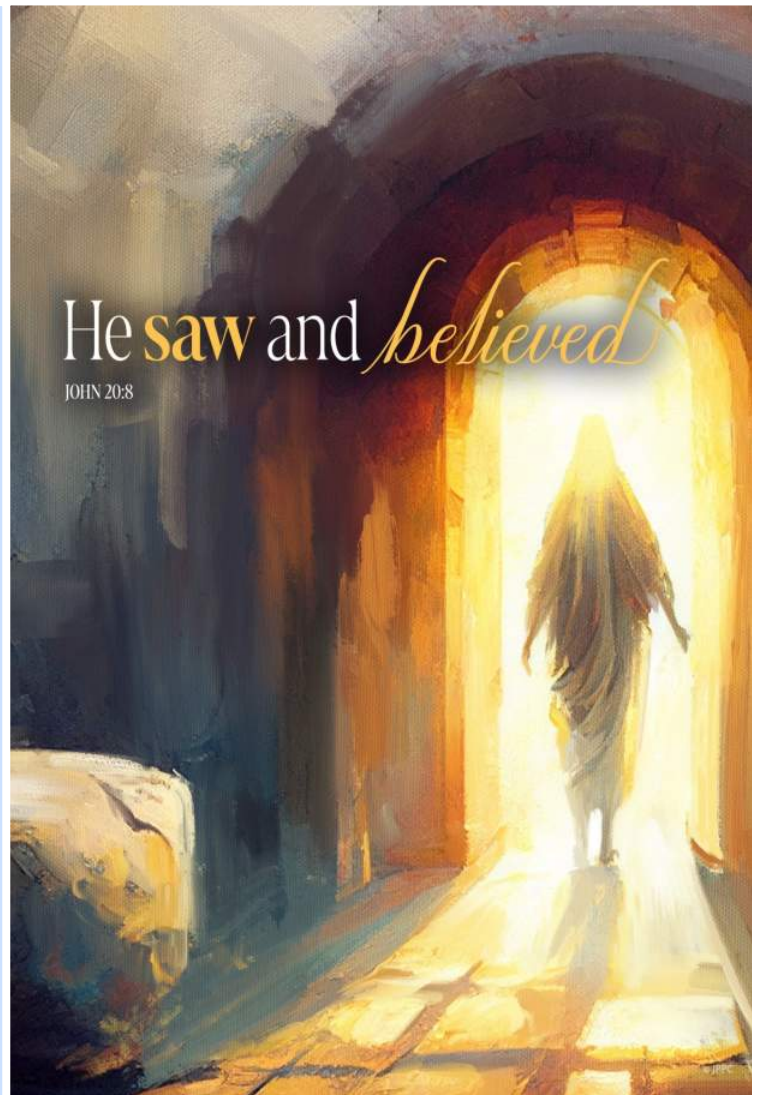

Baptism: For children 7 years of age or younger, parents and godparents (sponsors) must take a baptismal class. The child's birth certificate and a letter of eligibility from the current parish of the parents and godparents, if they are not attending the Cathedral, are required. According to the precepts of the church, all godparents must be 16 years of age or older, practicing the faith, and have completed all of their sacraments. It is possible to have only one sponsor. Baptism may be received at any age. For unbaptized adults, formation is available through the OCIA Program. 856-964-1580 EXT. 103

Religious Education: Our Religious Education program prepares youth (ages 7-15) to receive Baptism, First Communion (children 6 and older), and Confirmation (children 10 and older). Please contact the religious education program at 856-964-1580 EXT. 103. For baptism, registration is open all year round. Call us and we will assist you.

OCIA: Our OCIA program (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults) prepares youth (age 16 and older) and adults to receive baptism, first communion and confirmation. New registrations are taken throughout the year in our religious education office.

Annulment and Marriage: The necessary preparation requires that an appointment be made with one of the priests or deacon. For more information about an annulments, you may also call the Diocese Tribunal Office: 856-583-6162.

Anointing of the Sick: For extreme unction in the case of some who is near death, call day or night at 856-964-1580 and press 2. Call us to schedule an appointment to receive the sacrament before surgery or in case of serious mental or physical illness. For communion visits for sick or elderly parishioners who are unable to attend Mass, call us.

Quinceañeras or Sweet 16: The young lady should have completed or be in preparation to complete her sacraments. If not, Father can offer a blessing for her and we invite her to enroll in our religious education program.

Funerals: In order to plan as best as possible, we ask that the funeral home or the family member in charge of arrangements call us.

HAPPY EASTER!!!

Every year on Easter, I feel like I am at a loss for words.

I have to talk, preach, and write about our faith every single day, but this is always a day where I struggle to come up with what to say. How do we explain the most important day of the year with mere words? How do we capture the meaning of the fact that all of our hope lies in what we celebrate today? As is often the case when I don't know what to say, I am overcomplicating things and need to go back to the basics!

Today, we simply rejoice in the great story of Jesus, often called the "kerygma", or "proclamation." This is the heart of our faith: God created the world good, desiring to live in communion with us and giving us the freedom to enter into a loving relationship with Him. Yet, we did not use our freedom well, starting with our first parents and going down the line through history, we haven't trusted God and have continually tried to find the meaning of our lives on our own. Despite our sins, in His goodness and mercy, God Himself entered into His creation in Jesus, to rescue us from our sins and lead us back to Him.

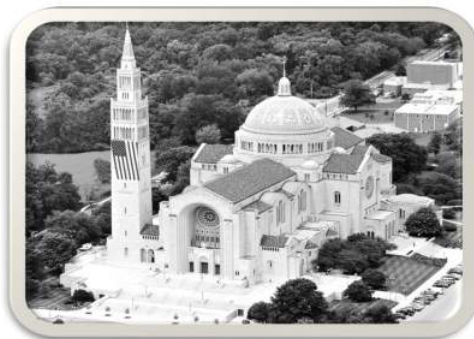
To bridge the gap between us and Him, Jesus gave Himself up to death, and by shedding His blood for us on the cross, gave us the ability to be forgiven and healed by His wounds. Jesus then rose from the dead, ascended into heaven, and sent the Holy Spirit so that we could be recreated and transformed by His loving grace. God now calls us to follow Him each day as His disciples, and sends us out to share this Good News with all of the world. So today, as we celebrate Easter together as a parish and with our families and friends, may we simply delight in the goodness of God, and share this greatest story ever told with everyone in our lives!

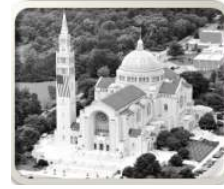
