## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

### Invite LGBTQ Catholics to OLG's Ninth Annual Pride Mass



After decades of progress in society as well as in the Church, the LGBTQ community is under attack by some segments in our country. To deflect from the failures we struggle with, people need a scapegoat. With fewer than one percent of the population in the U.S., transgender individuals have been targeted. This is dangerous, increasing violence against them and increasing the number of suicides. Instead of attacking people, we need to extend the hand of Jesus to help and heal all individuals who struggle with uncertainty and are targets of hate. This year's Pride Mass theme is, "Christ's Hands Heal Our Hurts."

In the spirit of accompaniment encouraged by Pope Francis with the support of our Archbishop, Joseph Cardinal Tobin, we welcome you to our 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Pride Mass on Sunday, June 14, 2026 at the 10:30 AM Mass. We have pride in all our brothers and sisters and do not reduce people to sexual labels. All are children of God and deserve to be able to worship in community and develop a relationship with God. Some of the language we have used in the past has been off putting and no wonder people stayed away from the church. Pope Francis encouraged us to start fresh and to journey with our LGBTQ brothers and sisters as he did.

Francis welcomed trans women to the Vatican including our good friend, Christine Zuba, and also offered a safe space for them. He often welcomed his gay friends to the Vatican. And even offered the church blessings for LGBTQ individuals.

We know that we have LGBTQ parishioners who reject any labels and simply worship as people of God. No one is taking their faith from them or depriving them of the love of God. We especially are proud of our parishioners who bring their children to Mass so they can grow up in an inclusive church.

With the spirit of God, the church renews itself for the good of all. Let's celebrate this new spirit. Please invite your LGBTQ Catholic friends and family to celebrate life with us.

# Kathleen Mc Graw Thanks Us for Supporting her Habitat for Humanity Service Project at Boston College

Thank you all so much for your support as I traveled to Kent County, Michigan, this past March to serve at Habitat for Humanity Kent County. I was privileged to serve the community there by working on multiple different homes alongside eleven other Boston College students. Together, we laid flooring, built door frames, applied siding, and so much more. We also had the opportunity to work in their ReStore, where they sell discounted items that have been reclaimed from other houses. Throughout the trip, we also engaged in nightly reflections that helped us to make sense of our service and grow closer to one another.

The staff of Habitat for Humanity Kent County made Michigan feel like a home away from home. They not only assisted us with technical skills, including using numerous types of power tools and materials, but ensured we were well fed, provided us with recommendations for local sights, and made an effort to get to know each of us. Two women, Stacy and Jamila, were with us every day of service. They had connected with our leaders for months preceding up to our trip, helped

us get our bearings at each worksite, and

were always ready with a wonderful lunch to fuel our work. They have both worked for Habitat for Humanity Kent County for the better part of their careers because they truly believe in the work they do. They don't have easy jobs, as they are responsible for overseeing all kinds of projects and service groups that come and go, but they do it all with joy, meeting people wherever they are coming from, and lifting up all those around them. To our group, they exemplified what it means to be men and women for and with others.

One of my favorite moments aside from service was doing a polar plunge in Lake Michigan. Despite most of the lake being frozen over, we trekked over the sand and initial ice to the water. There, we did a quick reflection (it was still early March and quite cold!) about thin spaces, which are spaces in which Heaven and Earth don't seem so far apart. Once we jumped in, Lake Michigan seemed to be a thin space because we weren't sure if we were about to die of hypothermia. However, once we got more settled that night after warm showers and food, I thought about how all of Kent County will forever be a thin space to me because of the people we were able to connect with and serve, and the friendships we made among each other.

I'm very grateful that I had the opportunity to serve and without your support, none of this would have been possible. Thank you all again and trust that you were in my prayers throughout this illuminating experience.
