Pastor's Letter

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Χριστός ἀνέστη! Ἀληθῶς ἀνέστη!

Christ is risen! Truly he is risen!

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Easter and Mother's Day as well. Happy Mother's Day to all the women who have shown us God's maternal love over the years.

As I write this on May 5, we are anticipating the papal Conclave to begin on May 7. By the time you read this, I don't know what will have happened. I encourage you to fast and pray so that those Cardinals who will be participating in the Conclave will be open to the inspirations of the Holy Spirit to choose the Holy Father that we need to best shepherd the Church during this challenging time in history. If the Conclave will have concluded by the time you read this, please pray for the new Holy Father.



In 2020, as the effects of Covid were beginning and there were so many unknowns, we began the ministry of a parish food pantry that we called Saint Joseph's Table. Kelly Wilton began this and then handed it on to Terri Miles. When Terri moved out of the area, Daniel Solares took over. After five years of tremendous service, the organizers have let me know that they can no longer continue to keep this ministry open. Covid is (at least largely) over. Last Sunday we had 877 people attend Mass between our 10 AM and 2 PM Masses. I will continue to keep an eye on this to see if we average at least 850 people between these two Masses to see if we begin a third Mass in Spanish in the fall.

Congratulations to the 40 young people who were confirmed on May 3 at our parish and the 37 children who made their First Communion on May 4. A big thank you to Kelly Wilton and her whole team of catechists for their generous giving of themselves to pass the faith on to a new generation. We pray that all of those who have received the sacraments will stay close to our Lord for the rest of their lives and avail themselves of the graces of the sacraments often.

In the Acts of the Apostles today we hear about resistance to the preaching of the Apostles. God brings good out of this by opening their ministry even more to the Gentiles.

In the book of Revelation (Apocalypse) John has a vision of a multitude that no one could count from people from all over the world. It is a beautiful image of our Church which is called "Catholic" which means universal. God desires the salvation of everyone. The people are dressed in white robes (a sign of their baptism) and hold palm branches (a sign of victory over persecution.) Many have witnessed to Jesus Christ by the shedding of their blood. As John writes: "they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb."

On the fourth Sunday of Easter, we traditionally celebrate the Good Shepherd and read part of the discourse of our Lord in John, Chapter 10. He tells us today that his sheep hear his voice and follow him. Let us ask our Lord for that grace, to hear his voice above the din of all the siren songs of modern culture and follow him by obeying his will.

Oramos para que todos los que han recibido los sacramentos permanezcan cerca de nuestro Señor por el resto de sus vidas y aprovechen las gracias de los sacramentos con frecuencia.

En los Hechos de los Apóstoles de hoy, escuchamos sobre la resistencia a la predicación de los Apóstoles. Dios saca provecho de esto al abrir aún más su ministerio a los gentiles. En el libro del Apocalipsis, Juan tiene una visión de una multitud incontable, proveniente de todas partes del mundo. Es una hermosa imagen de nuestra Iglesia, llamada «Católica», que significa universal. Dios desea la salvación de todos. En el cuarto domingo de Pascua, tradicionalmente celebramos al Buen Pastor y leemos parte del discurso de nuestro Señor en Juan, capítulo 10. Hoy nos dice que sus ovejas escuchan su voz y lo siguen. Pidamos a nuestro Señor esa gracia para escuchar su voz por encima del estruendo de los cantos de sirena de la cultura moderna y seguirlo obedeciendo su voluntad.

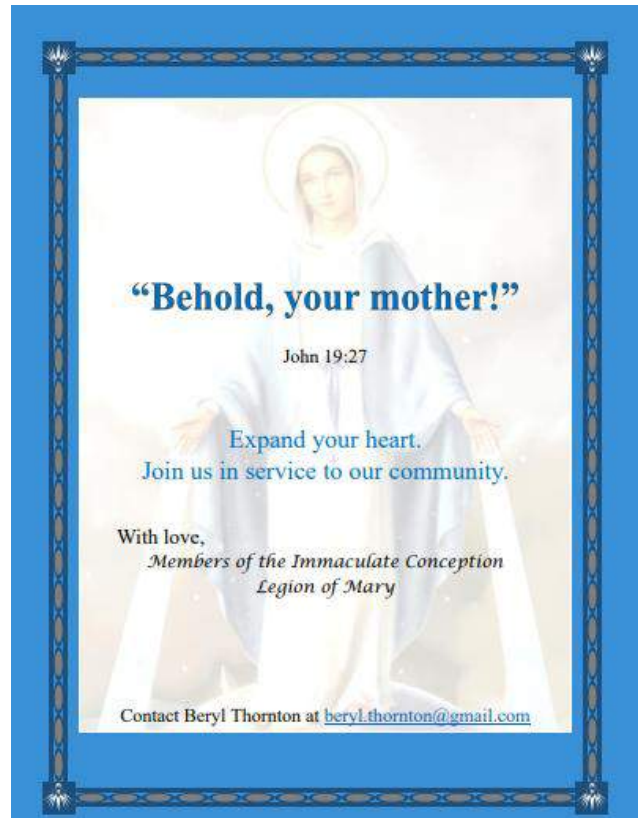

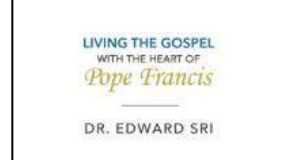

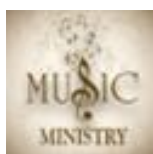

MUSIC MINISTRY: The oldest hymn known to Mary, "Beneath Thy Protection" in English, has been found on a papyrus dating back to 250 AD, meaning it was already used in the liturgy at the time, specifically the Christmas liturgy of the Coptic Church. This also means that this hymn to the Theotokos ("God-bearer" or "Mother of God") long predates the official declaration of Mary as Theotokos at the Council of Ephesus in 431.

The English text, which bears a striking resemblance to the popular Memorare prayer, reads: We fly to Thy protection, O Holy Mother of God; Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin. Amen. (www.aleteia.com)

MINISTERIO DE MÚSICA: El himno más antiguo conocido a María, "Bajo Tu Protección" en inglés, se ha encontrado en un papiro que data del año 250 d.C., lo que significa que ya se utilizaba en la liturgia de la época, concretamente en la liturgia navideña de la Iglesia copta. Esto también significa que este himno a la Theotokos ("Portadora de Dios" o "Madre de Dios") es muy anterior a la declaración oficial de María como Theotokos en el Concilio de Éfeso del año 431.

El texto en inglés, que guarda un sorprendente parecido con la popular oración Memorare, dice: Bajo tu protección nos acogemos, oh Santa Madre de Dios; no desprecies nuestras súplicas en nuestras necesidades, antes bien, líbranos siempre de todo peligro, oh Virgen Gloriosa y Bendita.
