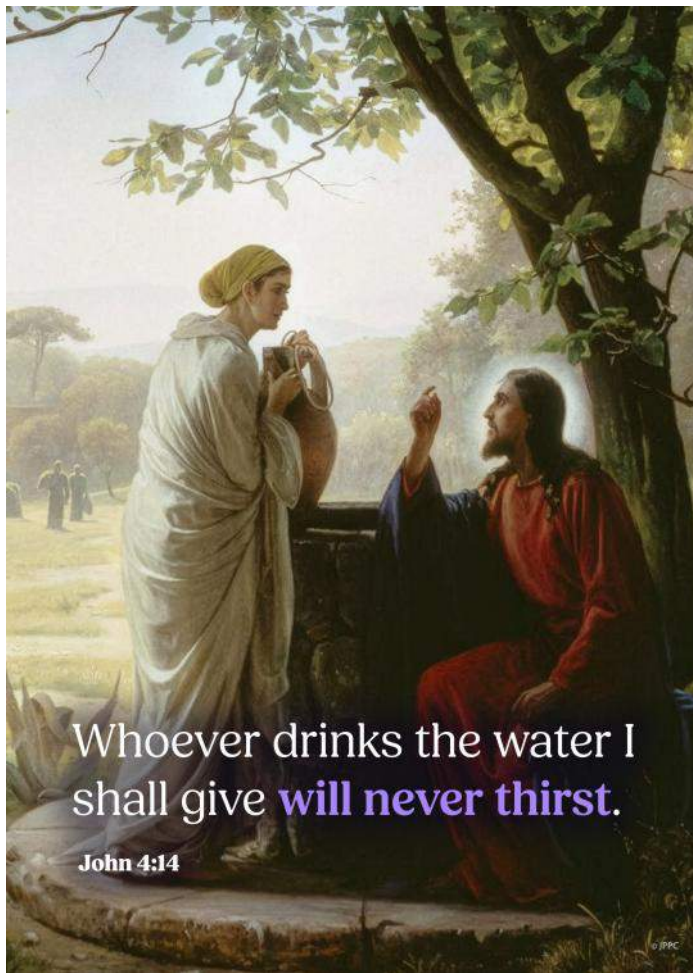

The **Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion** was held on **Sunday, February 22, 2026**, at **St. Michael's Cathedral** in Springfield. The event marked a pivotal moment in the spiritual journey of **150 soon-to-be Catholics**, including **59 catechumens** (unbaptized individuals) and **93 candidates** (baptized Christians seeking full communion with the Catholic Church).

**Catechumens** were formally presented and enrolled in the **Book of the Elect** by Bishop William D. Byrne, who affirmed their readiness to receive the sacraments of **Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist** at the **Easter Vigil on April 4, 2026**.

**Candidates** participated in the **Call to Continuing Conversion**, reaffirming their commitment to the Catholic faith and preparing to complete their initiation through Confirmation and First Communion. The celebration emphasized the Church's role in "**choosing**" those who are spiritually prepared, not based on personal decision alone, but as a response to God's call through the Church.

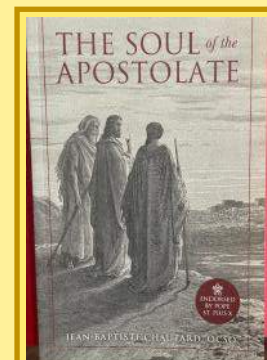

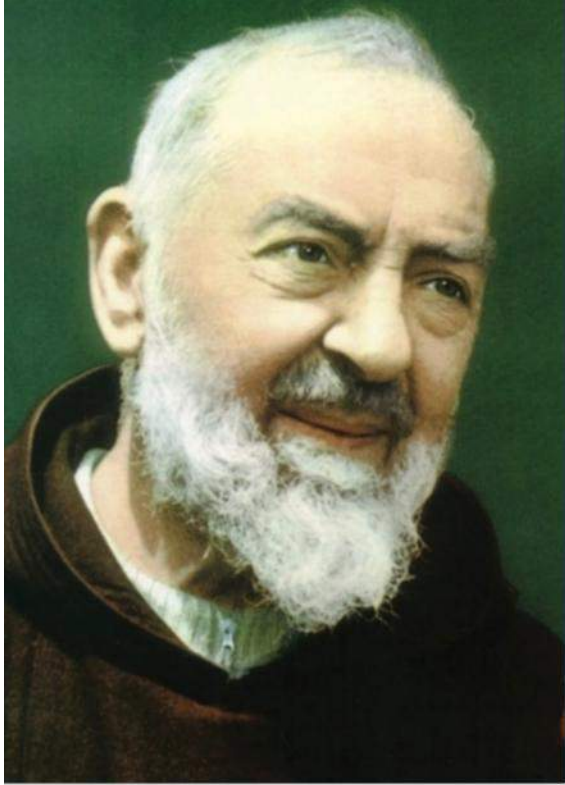

Please make your \$150 check payable to St. John the Evangelist Church and note "Bricks" in the memo line of the check. Orders may be turned in or mailed to St. John the Evangelist Church Parish Office, 833 Main Street, Agawam, MA 01001. Cash will also be accepted as well at the office, and a receipt can be provided. We will take orders for this first phase through April 30<sup>th</sup> with additional phases thereafter.

If ordering more than one brick, there should be one form for each brick, but you can submit one check for all bricks ordered with the total payment equal to the number of bricks purchased times \$150. Payment must be received before the brick can be engraved.

***Disclaimer:** The price of \$150 applies to the purchase, personalization, and installation of your donated brick. There is no guarantee to placement of the brick other than it will be on the property at 833 Main St., Agawam. All brick personalization will be reviewed and must be approved by the Brick Committee prior to engraving. Should the brick fade, wear, or become damaged, regardless of the time installed, the Church will not be responsible for replacing or repairing the brick. There will be no refunds once a brick has been engraved.*
